Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. (CEGC) is a licensed Natural Gas Supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is currently authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to provide natural gas services to residential, commercial, and governmental customers within the service territory of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania.

In December 1999, the Commission issued a license in Docket No. A-125050, authorizing CEGC (fka MXenergy Inc.), the right to begin to offer, render, furnish, or supply natural gas supply services to residential, commercial, and governmental customers in the service territories of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Peoples Natural Gas, and Equitable Gas. In September 2006, a request was filed to amend CEGC's license to include the additional service territories of UGI Utilities, Inc., PECO Energy Company and PPL Gas Utilities Corporation. In July 2007, the Commission granted CEGC's request to withdraw its September 2006 filing to amend CEGC's license that also included CEGC's request that the Commission remove both Equitable Gas Company and Peoples Natural Gas Company from its license.

CEGC respectfully requests the Commission amend CEGC's current license to also include the PECO, Peoples Natural Gas, Philadelphia Gas Works, and UGI Utilities service territories. In support of its request, CEGC is enclosing documentation from PECO, Peoples Natural Gas, Philadelphia Gas Works, and UGI Utilities indicating CEGC meets their creditworthiness standards.

Energy Acquisition is providing this notification letter that Constellation Energy Gas Choice has met the creditworthiness business requirement involved with the Pennsylvania Gas Choice - Low Volume Transportation program, pursuant to the receipt of an initial Surety of \$35,000.00 Guaranty. The Surety may be submitted to PECO via three acceptable forms; a Cash Deposit, a Letter of Credit, or a Surety bond. PECO will hold any surety to cover potential obligations to PECO and other system costs that could result from failure of a Supplier to meet its competitive Natural Gas Supply service delivery obligations.

Please note, although the creditworthiness requirements were met, as referenced within Section 7.13 (Creditworthiness of a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) Serving Low Volume Transportation Customers) of the Gas Service Tariff, PECO has the right to re-assess the creditworthiness of the company if PECO has any reason to suspect a change in the marketer's financial condition.

Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW") is aware that Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the services territory of Philadelphia Gas Works.

As you know, in making such an application, Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. will do business. As such, under its tariff, Philadelphia Gas Works could require Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Philadelphia Gas Works determines to be appropriate.

However, since you are just beginning the process with the PAPUC and the Philadelphia Gas Works to become a supplier, the Philadelphia Gas Works at this time will not require any type of bond or security.

If circumstances should change during the vetting of the application, Philadelphia Gas Works reserves the right to require security from Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. as it deems appropriate.

RE: UGI Financial Security Requirements

Dear Mr. Baker,

UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGIU") has reviewed the financial information of Exelon, Corporation ("Exelon"), parent company of Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc ("Constellation Energy Gas Choice"). Based on this review and your assertion that Exelon would provide a corporate guarantee on behalf of Constellation Energy Gas Choice in order to satisfy the requirement that Constellation Energy Gas Choice must post security as specified in the UGI Gas ("UGI") Supplier Coordination Tariff before it serves customers on the UGI distribution system, UGIU has determined that Constellation Energy Gas Choice has demonstrated adequate creditworthiness to satisfy any costs UGI may incur in the event it operates as a supplier of last resort due to a default on the part of Constellation Energy Gas Choice.

This determination may change in the event there is a material deterioration in Exelon's financial condition, if Constellation Energy Gas Choice's obligations to UGI exceed the amount of the financial security provided, if the financial security is withdrawn or is deemed to be null and void or inadequate due to the material financial deterioration of any guarantor, or if Constellation Energy Gas Choice fails to abide by the terms and conditions of the UGI Gas Tariff and the UGI Natural Gas Supplier Coordination Tariff.
