In accordance with the provisions of Act 294 of 1978 (66 Pa. C.S. \$332(h)), the decision of Administrative Law Judge James D. Porterfield dated August 23, 1985 has become final without further Commission action.

The applicant will not be permitted to operate or engage in any transportation granted by the enclosed order until he has complied with the following tariff requirement:

Prepare and file a tariff, instructions for which are enclosed.

Motor carriers operating without complying with the above requirement will be subject to the penalty provisions of the Public Utility Law.

Commission regulations require compliance with the above requirement within sixty days of the date of this letter. Failure to comply within the sixty day period will cause the Commission to rescind its action and dismiss the application without further proceedings.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc. at Docket No. A-00102471, F. 1, Am-F, be and is hereby approved and that the certificate issued to Applicant at Docket No. A-00102471, F. 1, on March 4, 1981, be amended to include the following operating authority as a motor common carrier:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property, except commodities in bulk and household goods and office furniture in use, for G. C. Murphy Company between points in Pennsylvania.

- 2: That the Applicant shall not provide any transportation services authorized herein until it complies with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.
- 3. That the authority granted herein, to the extent it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

4. That in the event said Applicant has not, on or before 60 days from the date of service of this order, complied with the requirements set forth above, the application shall be dismissed without further proceeding.
