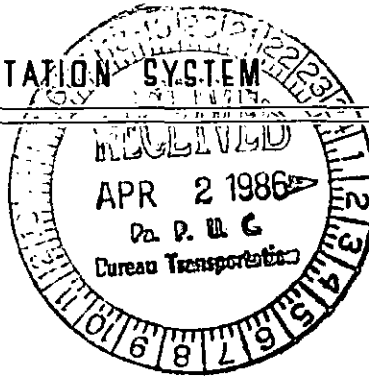

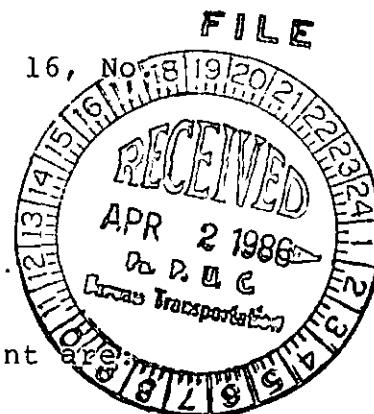

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property between points in the counties of Berks, Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Northampton and York, and from points in that said territory to points in the counties of Carbon, Columbia, Lackawanna, Luzerne, Lycoming, Northumberland, and Schuylkill, and vice versa.

2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, property from points in the counties of Berks, Carbon, Columbia, Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, Lackawanna, Lebanon, Lehigh, Luzerne, Lycoming, Northampton, Northumberland, Schuylkill and York, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

subject to the following conditions:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport commodities in bulk, household goods in use, or property which because of size or weight requires special handling or the use of special equipment such as winch trucks or tractors, pole trailers, extendible trailers, or carryalls.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport shipments between York, York County, Lancaster, Lancaster County, Harrisburg, Dauphin County, and Lebanon, Lebanon County, and within five (5) miles of the limits of said cities.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport heat exchangers and parts and accessories thereof, and materials and supplies used or useful in the production, distribution or installation thereof, between points in the borough of Lykens, Dauphin County, and points within an airline distance of two (2) statute miles of the limits of said borough, and from said points to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property for AMP, Incorporated, between its plants, warehouses and other facilities located in the counties of Adams, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lancaster, Perry, Schuylkill, Snyder and York, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania in and east of the western boundaries of the counties of Tioga, Lycoming, Clinton, Centre, Mifflin, Juniata and Franklin, and vice versa.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property, from the facilities owned or utilized by Weber Industrial Service, Inc., located in the city of York and the township of Dover, York County and in the city of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa.

To transport, property, (except commodities in bulk, household goods in use, or property which, because of size or weight, requires special handling or the use of special equipment such as winch trucks or tractors, pole trailers, extendible trailers or carry-alls): (1) Between points in the counties of Bradford, Butler, Cameron, Centre, Clarion, Clearfield, Clinton, Crawford, Elk, Erie, Forest, Jefferson, Lawrence, Mercer, Monroe, Montour, McKean, Pike, Potter, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, Venango, Warren and Wayne; and from points in the said counties, to points in the counties of Adams, Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Fayette, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Huntingdon, Indiana, Juniata, Mifflin, Perry, Snyder, Somerset, Union, Washington and Westmoreland, and vice versa; with the right to interchange traffic with Class A, Class B and Class D carriers so authorized: and (2) From points in the counties of Adams, Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Bedford, Blair, Bradford, Butler, Cambria, Cameron, Centre, Clarion, Clearfield, Clinton, Crawford, Elk, Erie, Fayette, Forest, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Huntingdon, Indiana, Jefferson, Juniata, Lawrence, Mercer, Mifflin, Monroe, Montour, McKean, Perry, Pike, Potter, Snyder, Somerset, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, Union, Venango, Warren, Washington, Wayne and Westmoreland, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; with the right to interchange traffic with Class A, Class B and Class D carriers so authorized.

subject to the following conditions:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property between points in any one of the following Counties as well as between points in any one of the named Counties to a point or points in any of the other named Counties: Allegheny, Beaver, Lawrence, Westmoreland, Indiana, Clearfield, Centre, Mercer, Butler, Jefferson, Armstrong, Cameron, Elk, Fayette, Green, Cambria and Washington.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property originating at points in the County of Centre on flatbed vehicles.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property for AMP, Incorporated between points in Pennsylvania.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property, except commodities in bulk, household goods in use or property which, because of size or weight requires special handling or the use of special equipment such as winch trucks or tractors, pole trailers, extendible trailers or carryalls, from the facilities owned or utilized by Weber Industrial Service, Inc., located in the city of York and the township of Dover, York County, and in the city of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling, in connection with a removal by a householder from one house or dwelling to another; furniture, fixtures, equipment and the property of stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, when a part of stock, equipment or supply of such stores, offices, museums, institutions, hospitals or other establishments, in connection with a removal from one location to another; and articles, including objects of art, displays and exhibits, which, because of their unusual nature or value, require specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property to or from the facilities of (a) Glenshaw Glass Company, Inc. located in the borough of Glenshaw, Allegheny County, (b) Sewell Plastics, Inc. located in Westmoreland County, (c) Pierce Glass Company located in the borough of Port Allegany, McKean County, (d) Classic Industries, Inc. located in Westmoreland County, or (e) Owens-Illinois, Inc. located in Clarion County.

FOLDER 1, Am-FF

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property for National Can Corporation.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport petroleum and petroleum products, vehicle body sealers, deadener compounds, containers and pallets from points in the Counties of McKean and Venango to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; except to or from the Counties of Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, Montour and Philadelphia.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport paper and paper products and plastic materials between the facilities of Scott Paper Company located in the Counties of Bucks and Delaware and from said facilities to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property to and from Sky Bros., Inc. or Frozen Farms Products, Inc. from the township of Allegheny, Blair County, to points in Pennsylvania and vice versa.
