SUPPLEMENT TO PARAGRAPH 8

SCOPE OF AUTHORITY SOUGHT

The nature and character of the service to be rendered by applicant as a common carrier is as follows:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property from points in that part of Pennsylvania on and west of U.S. Highway Route 219 to points in that part of Pennsylvania on and east of U.S. Highway Route 219, and vice versa; with the right to interchange property with Class A, Class B and Class D carriers so authorized.

Subject to the following restriction:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods and office furniture in use, property in bulk, or property which because of size or weight requires the use of special equipment.
