Dear Mr. Rich:

On behalf of Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc., we have been authorized to amend the above application to read in its entirety as follows:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property (except commodities in bulk and household goods and office furniture in use) for Dauphin Distribution Services Company, from its facilities located in Cumberland County to points in Pennsylvania, and vice vers

Subject to the following conditions:

FIRST: That no right, power or privilege is glanted AN 25 1988 to transport any single parcel or package weighing less than 200 pounds which originates in the county of Philadelphia.

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport shipments on flatbed trailers.

In reliance upon the presentation of this amendment, the protest of Butler Trucking Company was withdrawn by its attorney, Dwight L. Koerber, Jr., Esquire, by letter dated January 19, 1988. We believe this will also result in the withdrawal of the protest of American Eagle Express, Inc. and we ask that its representative so notify the Commission as soon as possible.
