To Whom It May Concern:

Your attention is directed to a letter from the Commission dated March 13, 1987 together with the Order of the Commission notifying you of the Commission's approval of the application for amendment to the certificate of public convenience in the above entitled proceeding, limited and restricted to certain definite rights.

The letter states that the applicant would be required to file with the Commission within sixty days of the date of the letter a tariff of its rates and charges.

Motor carriers operating without complying with the requirements are operating illegally and subject to the penalty provisions of the Public Utility Law.

Our records show that you have failed to comply with the tariff requirements. Unless this requirement is complied with immediately, the Commission will rescind the action of 3/5/87 approving the application and dismiss it without further proceedings.
