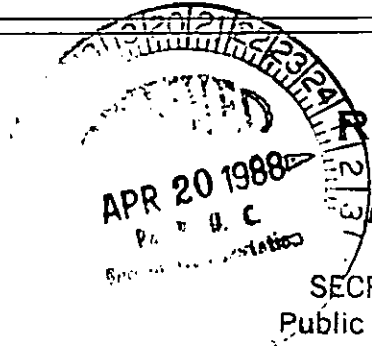

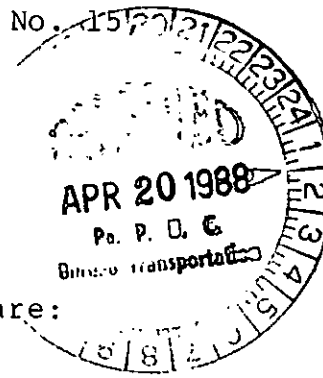

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport heat exchangers and parts and accessories thereof, and materials and supplies used or useful in the production, distribution or installation thereof, between points in the borough of Lykens, Dauphin County, and points within an airline distance of two(2) statute miles of the limits of said borough, and from said points to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

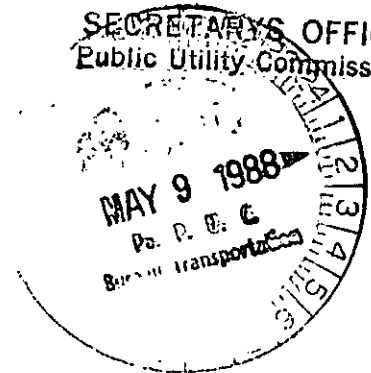

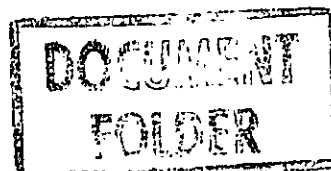
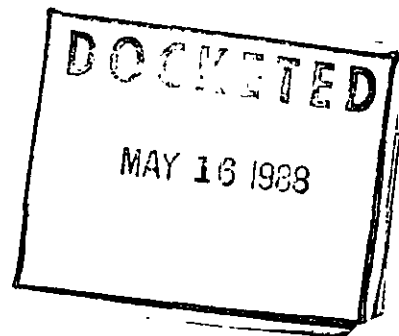
The Public Utility Code directs that hearings shall be commenced in this case by the Administrative Law Judge within 90 days after the proceeding is initiated.
