

- (a) Application of Pitt-Ohio Express, Inc., for amendment to its certificate to permit the transportation of property from points in the western third of the Commonwealth to points in the eastern two-thirds of the Commonwealth, and vice versa.
- By application filed on August 4, 1986, and subsequently amended, (b) Applicant seeks authority, generally, to transport property from the western third of the state to the central third of the state, and vice versa. During five days of hearing in 1989, 19 applicant witnesses and 2 protestant witnesses testified. Briefs were filed on behalf of both the Applicant and the Protestants.
- ALJ Porterfield's Initial Decision grants the application, as amended, (C) because the Applicant demonstrated a useful public purpose responsive to a public need for the proposed service and demonstrated technical and financial ability to provide the proposed service. There was no evidence that implementation of the proposed service will endanger or impair the operations of the Protestants or other motor common carrier
