ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

BY THE COMMISSION:

This Commission, as the duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regular and control motor carriers operating within the Commission, represents as follows:

1. That Hugo's Services, Inc., respondent, was issued a contract carrier permit at A-00099401 on November 12, 1975.
2. That respondent in his annual reports filed with the Commission as required by 66 Pa. C.S. §510(b), reported no revenue from intrastate operations for the period 1984 through 1986.
3. That the services previously offered or furnished by respondent are no longer in the public interest.
4. That, alternatively, respondent failed to report his intrastate revenues as required by 66 Pa. C.S. §510(b); THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent show cause why his contract carrier permit should not be cancelled.


2. That respondent has twenty (20) days from the date on which this order to show cause is served to file with the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17120, an answer (original and two copies), in writing, under oath, which, as required by 1 Pa. Code §35.37, either affirms or specifically denies the allegations set forth in this order to show cause.

3. That, if respondent fails to file an answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days, the Commission may enter an order cancelling the contract carrier permit.

4. That, if respondent files an answer in which the allegations set forth above are admitted, the Commission may enter an order cancelling the contract carrier permit.

5. That, if respondent files a timely answer which specifically denies the allegations, or which raises material questions of law or fact, the order to show cause shall be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision.
