On November 2, 2011, by Secretarial Letter of the Commission, the Certificate of Public Convenience of Jadon Trucking, Inc., Respondent, was cancelled for failure to maintain evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability on file with this Commission, a violation of the Public Utility Code at 66 Pa. C. S. §512, 52 Pa. Code §32.2(c), and 52 Pa. Code §32.11(a), §32.12(a), or §32.13(a). The same Secretarial Letter assessed a fine of \$500.00 for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this Commission in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §32, and requested that the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation put an administrative hold on Respondent's vehicle registration(s).

The Commission has the power to amend a Secretarial Letter in light of newly discovered change of circumstances which justify reconsideration. Respondent's Insurance Company, has admitted to filing the incorrect form, which generated a suspension letter, a complaint letter, and cancellation of Respondent's PUC Authority. Commission has received all required insurance filings and Respondent is now in compliance with all insurance requirements. Respondent, is also reminded of his responsibility to respond to all applicable Commission correspondence and become thoroughly acquainted with the Commission's regulations.

Therefore, the Secretarial Letter, dated November 2, 2011, at C-2011-2252360, A-00100411, directing Respondent to pay a fine of \$500.00 for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this Commission in accordance with 52 Pa Code§32, is hereby withdrawn.


Furthermore, the Secretarial Letter, dated **November 2, 2011**, at C-2011-2252360, A-00100411, requested that the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to put an administrative hold on Respondent's vehicle registrations is hereby withdrawn.

The Respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience issued to the Respondent at A-00100411 has been *reinstated*.
