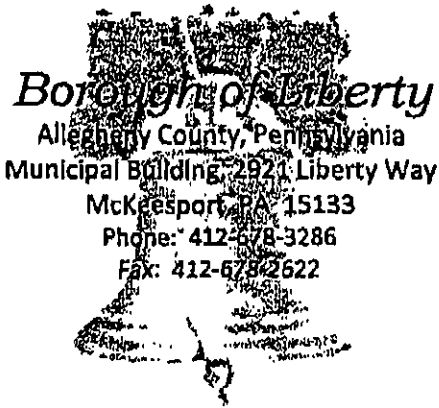

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF LIBERTY, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, URGING THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION TO DENY THE PROPOSED RATE INCREASE REQUESTED BY DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE DISTRIBUTION TO ITS CUSTOMERS AS FILED WITH THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION ON AUGUST 2, 2013, AT DOCKET NO. R-2013-2372129.

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2013, Duquesne Light Company filed a request with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) to increase rates for electric distribution service for residents of the Borough of Liberty as well as residents of all other municipalities who are provided electric distribution services by Duquesne Light Company; and

WHEREAS, the economic situation in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has made it increasingly harder for residents of the Borough of Liberty to meet the financial burdens placed upon them; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Liberty urges the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) to deny the request of Duquesne Light Company to increase electric rates to relieve the extreme financial burden that this rate increase would cause to residents of the Borough of Liberty.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ADOPTED By the Council of the Borough of Liberty, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby RESOLVED and ADOPTED by authority of the same, that:

1. The Council of the Borough of Liberty urges the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) to deny the proposed rate increase for electric distribution service requested by Duquesne Light Company in its filing with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on August 2, 2013.


