Dear Mr. Daniels:

Under date of October 20, 1980, the Secretary's office transmitted to you the Commission's compliance order of October 9, 1980, evidencing approval of the above carrier's application at A. 00102306, which is in effect a transfer of the rights formerly held by J. Bernard Klapec at A. 82176. The letter transmitting the order directs attention to the requirement for the filing of a tariff.

In accordance with the provisions of Pa. Code, Title 52, Section 23.13(c), you should immediately arrange to file adoption supplements with us whereby the tariffs of the former operator will become the tariffs of the latter, and no change in rates is permitted to cover the transfer of rights. To assist you in meeting this tariff requirement, we are enclosing three copies of each of the necessary supplements to be properly executed by you, the original and one copy of each of which must be returned to us for filing and the remaining ones to be retained for your records. Upon the proper filing of the adoption supplements, the tariff requirements will be satisfied.

Dear Sir:

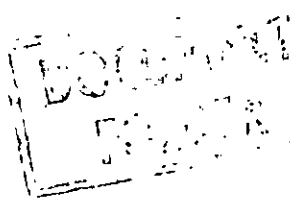
Your attention is directed to a letter from the Commission dated October 20, 1980 together with the compliance order of the Commission, notifying you of the Commission's approval of the application for a certificate of public convenience in the above entitled proceeding, limited and restricted to certain definite rights.

The letter states that the applicant would be required to file with the Commission within sixty days (60) of the date of the letter a certificate of insurance or other security and a tariff of its rates and charges and that the certificate of public convenience authorizing actual operations would not be issued until the compliance with these requirements.

Motor carriers operating without complying with these requirements and hence without a certificate are operating illegally and subject to the penalty provisions of the Public Utility Law.

Our records show that you have failed to comply with the tariff & insurance requirement. Unless the requirement is complied with immediately, the Commission will rescind the action of October 9, 1980 approving the application and dismiss it without further proceeding.

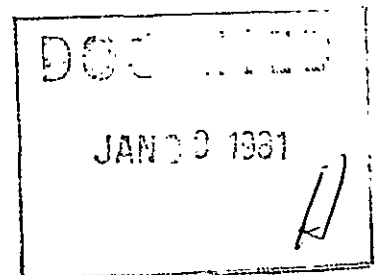
