

 - (b) This matter comes before the Commission on a Letter/Petition for Declaratory Order filed by James C. Logan, Inc. (Logan) on March 20, 1986. Logan has the authority under a certificate issued by the Commission to transport articles requiring specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods. By the instant Petition, Logan seeks to eliminate his uncertainty as to whether this authority includes the right to transport business machines.



James C. Logan, Inc.; Letter/Petition for Declaratory Order

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

A certificate of public convenience was issued to James C. Logan, Inc. (Logan) on May 30, 1973 at A-00097635. The certificate authorizes Logan to, inter alia, transport articles requiring specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods.

On March 20, 1986, Logan filed a Letter/Petition for Declaratory Order, which is now before the Commission for disposition. By this Petition, Logan seeks to eliminate his uncertainty as to whether the above-described authority includes the right to transport business machines. Specifically, Logan desires to transport new IBM equipment, Xerox equipment or newly-manufactured equipment that requires specialized handling under his current operating authority.

Petitions for declaratory orders are governed by Section 331(f) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §331(f) and the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §5.42. Inasmuch as the instant Petition satisfies the requirements set forth therein, and raises a legitimate question concerning the interpretation of a certificate issued by the Commission, the Petition is properly before the Commission at this time.

It appears that the Commission decision in Application of Bekins Moving & Storage, A-00075976, F.3, Am-D (order entered February 15, 1978) is dispositive of the issue raised by Logan. In Bekins, the carrier held the same authority as held by Logan, and the Commission concluded that the carrier's authority did not include the right to transport business machines. In so ruling, the Commission explained that its policy has been to enumerate in specific detail the rights conferred upon a carrier by a certificate of public convenience. The Commission noted that to interpret the carrier's authority as including the right to transport business machines would constitute an unwarranted and extensive expansion of that authority. Furthermore,

such an interpretation might adversely affect those carriers who have obtained the specific authority to transport business machines. The Commission's conclusion and rationale in <u>Bekins</u> were recently reaffirmed in <u>Re Pennsylvania Moving & Storage Association</u>, P-850090 (Order entered April 2, 1986).

Based upon these prior decisions of the Commission, Logan's authority to transport articles requiring specialized handling and equipment usually employed in moving household goods does not include the right to transport business machines, such as IBM or Xerox equipment; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the Letter/Petition for Declaratory Order filed by James C. Logan, Inc. on March 20, 1986 is hereby granted.
- 2. That the certificate of public convenience issued to James C. Logan, Inc. at A-00097635 does not authorize the transportation of business machines.
