

COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Transportation and Safety and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

- That Superior Moving & Storage, Inc., respondent, maintains a principal place of 1. business at 5101 Unruh Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 17795, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19135-0795.
- That respondent was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience by this Commission on September 22, 1982, at Application Docket No. A-00103923.
- That respondent, on February 25, 2005, transported household goods for Denise Thomas from 2058 Maple Avenue, Hatfield, Pennsylvania to 11 Aston Lane, Gilbertsville, Pennsylvania. On March 24, 2005. Enforcement Officer John Theodosiades spoke to Mr. Mark Brenfleck, who confirmed that Denise Thomas was given a verbal estimate of \$400. Respondent charged Ms. Thomas \$51 for accessorial charges with \$82 per hour for one van and three men for 5.5 hours for a total of \$517, which is an underestimate of \$117. Respondent's tariff reveals that the hourly rate for one van and three men should have been \$75; therefore, the correct charge should have been \$463.50 and shipper was overcharged \$53.50. Following discussion with Enforcement Officer Theodosiades, respondent issued a refund of \$100 to the shipper. Additionally, the shipper was not provided with a written estimate or "Information for Shippers" statement and a quarterly underestimate report was not filed with this Commission.
- That respondent, by charging a higher rate than that specified in the tariff on file with this Commission, violated 66 Pa. C.S. §1303. The penalty is \$500.
- That respondent, by failing to use and complete the written form for estimates of charges 5. titled "Estimated Costs of Service," violated 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2). The penalty is \$250.
- That respondent, by failing to furnish the complainant with an "Information for Shippers" statement prior to the preparation of an order for service, violated 52 Pa. Code §31.121(a). The penalty is \$250.
- That respondent, by failing to file a quarterly report of the underestimate with this Commission, violated 52 Pa. Code §31.124. The penalty is \$100.





WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety Prosecutory Staff hereby requests that the Commission fine Superior Moving & Storage, Inc. the sum of one thousand and one hundred dollars (\$1.100) for the illegal activities described in this complaint and order such other remedy as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.

- B. If you fail to answer this complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty.

- E. If you file an answer which contests the complaint, the matter will be assigned to an administrative law judge for hearing and decision. The judge is not bound by the optional fine set forth above.
