On May 30 and August 31, 1995, the Commission sent billings to your company for your assessment for our 1995-96 fiscal year. You have made no payment on the total assessment of \$12.00.

You are directed to pay the outstanding amount of your assessment by January 5, 1996. Your check or money order, payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, should be forwarded to Carmon Bass, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265. Failure to make timely payment will result in the institution of an action to cancel your certificate of public convenience.

In the event that your certificate is cancelled, additional action will follow. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S.A. §510(c), we may request the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to revoke the vehicle registrations of all your motor vehicles licensed in Pennsylvania. Also, we will notify the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue that you are no longer eligible for sales and use tax exemption as a common carrier under our jurisdiction. Finally, we will notify your insurance carrier that your company cannot lawfully provide service within this Commonwealth.


This letter is in response to your request, dated October 16, 1996, for amendment to your existing authority so as to allow the transportation of property (excluding household goods in use) between points in Pennsylvania.

At the time of the federal preemption of state regulation of property (excluding household goods in use) common carriers, your company held the right to transport 'aircraft'. Since this description fell into the general category of property, you were deemed to be a common carrier of property and obtained the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, property,
excluding household goods in use,
between points in Pennsylvania.

Thus, your company already holds the authority requested. It only needs to maintain its insurance coverage to retain the right. Please be aware, however, that the household goods portion of the authority is still subject to the geographical area restrictions and tariff requirements.

During the month of July 1996, Enforcement Officer George Hogan conducted a household goods review of your business operations for the months of March 1995, through May 1996.

The following four (4) moves reflected violations of 52 Pa. Code §31.121(a) for failure to furnish the shipper with an "Information for Shippers" statement:

- (a) Margareta Arnold, March 24, 1995
- (b) Mr. and Mrs. Bradbury, March 24, 1995
- (c) Alberta Eretzian, March 21, 1996
- (d) Fred Greenholz, May 26, 1996.

Please be informed that when a prospective shipper requests moving and before an order for service is prepared, the household goods carrier shall furnish the prospective shipper with a statement entitled "Information for Shippers" as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.121(a) of which the bottom part has to include the name of the shipper, the date certified that the information for shipper was furnished to this person and the signature of the carrier representative. The carrier shall retain a copy of this certification with the shipping order.

The following move reflect violations of 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), for failure to use and execute a proper form for estimates of charges titled "Estimated Cost of Services":

- (a) Mr. and Mrs. Bradbury, March 24, 1995.

The shipper shall be given a completed estimate of charges on the proper form as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), even if an estimate is given over the telephone in advance.

The following move reflects a violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1303, by charging a lesser rate than that specified in the Tri-State Household Goods Tariff at Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 54, Transportation Rate Table B on file with this Commission:

- (a) In the household good move made for Fred Greenholz on May 26, 1996, you charged \$672.00, as opposed to the correct charge of \$712.00, resulting in an undercharge of \$40.00.
