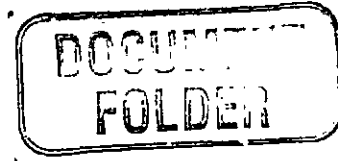

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER
CONTRACT CARRIER PERMIT

BY THE COMMISSION:

By an application filed on May 7, 1991, docketed at A-00105185, F. 2, McHale's Delivery Service, Inc., has applied for common carrier operating authority, and to convert the contract carrier permit it holds at A-00105185, F. 1, to a common carrier certificate.

We find it to be in the public interest to convert the contract carrier permit now held by McHale's Delivery Service, Inc., at A-00105185, F. 1, to a common carrier certificate in order to eliminate dual operations by a single carrier in keeping with the provisions of 66 Pa. C.S. §2504; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with the conditions and requirements as set forth in the order at A-00105185, F. 2, all the operating rights and the contract carrier permit held at A-00105185, F. 1, be and are hereby cancelled, and all rights, powers, and privileges granted thereby shall forthwith cease and terminate.
