ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE
OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

By an Order to Show Cause entered on August 26, 1993, this Commission directed respondent to show cause why its certificate of public convenience should not be cancelled. This action was prompted by respondent's failure to file its 1992 Assessment Report on or before March 31 as mandated by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. Section 510(b) and 52 Pa. Code Sections 29.43 or 31.10.

Our Order to Show Cause directed that an answer or the assessment report be filed within twenty (20) days and that, in the absence of any filing, the allegations in the order would be deemed admitted.

The Order to Show Cause was served on respondent on September 14, 1993 and, to date, more than twenty (20) days later, respondent has failed to file an answer or an assessment report as directed in this Commission's Order to Show Cause; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the allegations in the instant Order to Show Cause are deemed admitted.
2. That the instant Order to Show Cause is hereby made absolute.



3. That the certificate of public convenience held by respondent at Docket No. A-00105185 is hereby cancelled in its entirety.

4. That respondent cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1101, et seq. and the regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §1.1, et seq. In view of the cancellation of respondent's certificate of public convenience, respondent is specifically prohibited from rendering service as a common carrier by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

5. That, since respondent has no remaining authority, all remaining records pertaining to it are hereby marked CLOSED.
