section or paragraph.

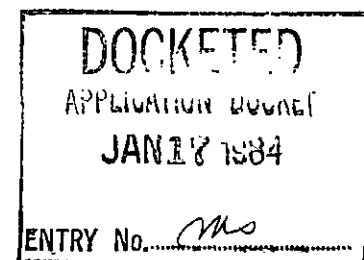
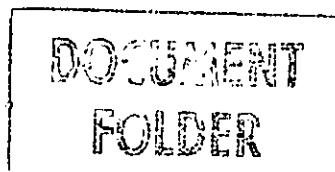
