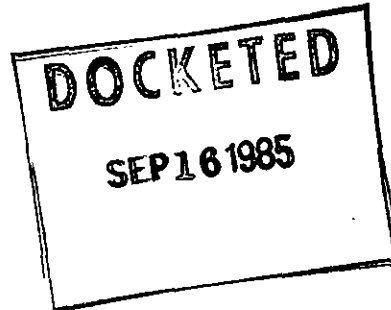

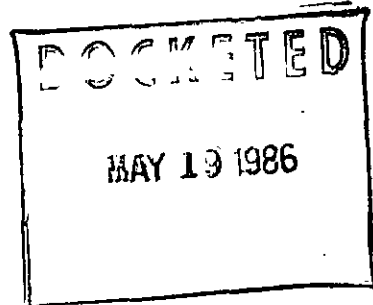

Please give this matter your immediate attention, as your certificate of public convenience could be cancelled.

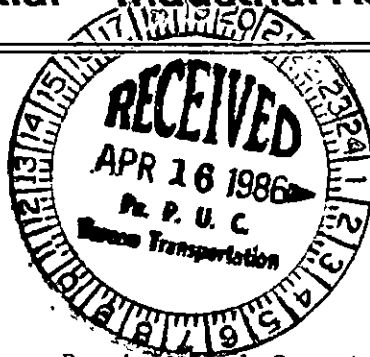

1. Legal Name and Domicile of Supporting Party or Firm

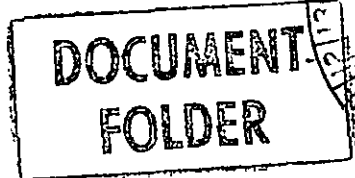
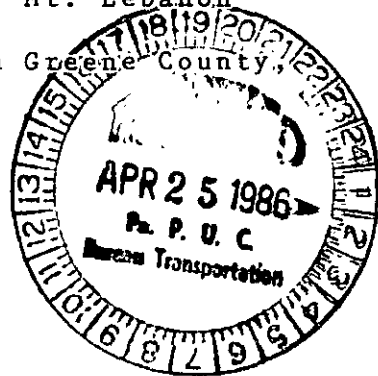
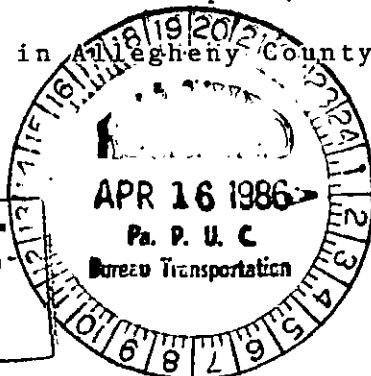
The legal name of the supporting firm is Burrell Construction & Supply Company. The company has its principal office located in New Kensington, Westmoreland County, PA.

2. Identity and Qualifications of Person Making Statement

My name is Herman Alvarez, and I am Manager of the Donora facility of Burrell Construction & Supply Company. I have been employed by Burrell for twenty-five years. The company has been in business for fifty years. I am familiar with the transportation requirements of Burrell Construction Company generally, and I am authorized by my company to support the application of Victor Paving and Construction.

3. General Description of Supporting Party

Burrell Construction Company is engaged in road construction, general excavation, and also as a material supplier and aggregate supplier. We have facilities located at various points in western Pennsylvania, including our facility in Donora, two plants in Greensburg, two facilities in New Kensington, a plant in Monaca, and a plant in Moon Township, Allegheny County. We have construction jobs which are ongoing at various locations in the application area. Presently, we have jobs located in Baldwin, and in Bethel Park, Allegheny County. We have had jobs in McKeesport, Elizabeth Township, Mt. Lebanon and Dormont, in Allegheny County, Waynesburg, in Greene County,



North Strabane, Washington County and points on Interstate 70 in Washington County and we have had jobs in Fayette and Westmoreland Counties in the recent past.

4. Volume and Frequency of Intended Use

We intend, and need, to use the applicant's service daily. As a major road construction and excavation company, as well as a major material and aggregate supplier, we have a need for the transportation of salt.

We are a major supplier of road deicing salt or anti-skid materials, throughout points in western Pennsylvania. We ship approximately 200,000 tons of road deicing salt or anti-skid materials from September thru March. This material is shipped from Donora, Washington County, to such customers as PennDOT, Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, various counties, such as Westmoreland and Allegheny, various townships and municipalities located within 100 miles of Donora. For example, we ship salt to such points as Somerset and Bedford, located in Somerset and Bedford counties respectively. We have shipped to points in Cambria County, Fayette County, Greene County, Westmoreland County, and Allegheny County. We have also shipped, in the past, to Indiana and Armstrong Counties. The destination points vary frequently, because salt is stockpiled at different locations and these locations may vary from year to year.

5. Type of Service Required

We require a carrier that can provide both tri-axle dump trucks, tractor and dump trailers, and a tractor with a trailer suitable for transporting salt. Applicant has this type of equipment. We also need a carrier that can provide service on short notice. Although, most of our transportation requirements are scheduled, at least one day in advance of when service is needed, we frequently must call upon carriers for immediate pick up and delivery of shipments. The applicant has always attempted to accommodate Burrell in this regard in connection with its present authority. We believe that the applicant has the proper equipment and expertise to meet our scheduled and emergency delivery requirements throughout the application area.

6. Similar Applications Supported


To the best of my knowledge, Burrell Construction & Supply Company is not presently supporting any similar application.

7. Other Pertinent Information

As stated previously, Burrell Construction & Supply Company has been in business for fifty years. Although we do have some equipment that is used in private carriage, we rely substantially upon common carriers, and we frequently need additional equipment. My job includes making certain that we have sufficient truckers to move salt material needed by our customers.

We also need transportation of construction equipment. This equipment might be needed anywhere at our various jobs. It might be necessary for the applicant to transport construction equipment from one jobsite to another. In addition, it might be necessary for the applicant to transport construction equipment from our plants to jobsites or to other plants. This equipment must be moved promptly, upon request, since the continuance of other jobs might be dependent upon the prompt delivery of construction equipment.

Burrell Construction & Supply Company would definitely benefit from the availability of the applicant's service throughout the application area, and we urge the Commission to approve this application.
