NOTICE OF RFP RESULTS FOR THE ENHANCED 2013/2014 WINTERTIME LEAK SURVEY

Dear Mr. Metro:

Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission's") Final Order entered in the above-captioned proceeding ("Final Order"), which approved the Company's Leak Detection Pilot Program ("LDPP") for the City of Allentown, I write to inform you that UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division ("Company") has successfully conducted the Commission-approved Request-For-Proposal ("RFP") process to solicit bids for the enhanced 2013/2014 wintertime leak survey to be performed in the City of Allentown from November 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014. The LDPP includes the implementation of additional quarterly leak surveys from April 1, 2013 through November 30, 2013 and the use of an enhanced wintertime survey from November 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014.

The Company has entered into an effective contract with the winning bidder of the RFP – Precision Pipeline Solutions, LLC – and has commenced the enhanced 2013/2014 wintertime leak surveys as of the date hereof. Precision Pipeline Solutions will employ SENSIT Technology VMD mobile infrared survey equipment and SENSIT IRed ethane detection instruments when performing the enhanced 2013/2014 wintertime leak surveys. Additionally, Precision Pipeline Solutions will utilize up to four leak survey technicians to survey approximately 90 miles of main and 3,760 services located in the City of Allentown.

In accordance with the Commission's Final Order in this proceeding, the Company will provide a written report to the Commission on or before June 1, 2014 describing the results of the LDPP.
