Dear Sir:

The Commission's records indicate that you have failed to comply with the necessary requirements of the Commission's order and cover letter which was sent to you on November 30, 1983. Specifically, you have failed to satisfy the requirements marked below:

- File a certificate of public liability and property damage insurance (Form E).
- File a cargo insurance certificate in the amount of \$2500 per vehicle (Form UCPC-31) or a cargo waiver.
- File an acceptable tariff.

The grant of your application was expressly subject to the fulfilling of all of the three conditions within sixty (60) from November 22, 1983.

Since you have not complied with the marked requirement(s), your application for a certificate of public convenience is hereby dismissed.

Since you do not have a certificate of public convenience, any operation as a motor carrier in intrastate commerce is a violation of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. s101 et seq, and will subject you to the penalties contained therein.
