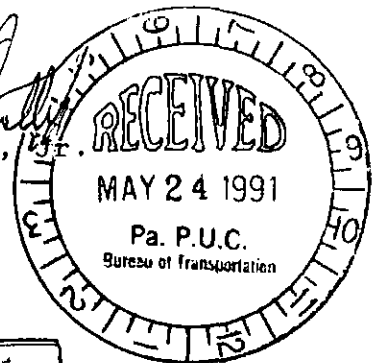

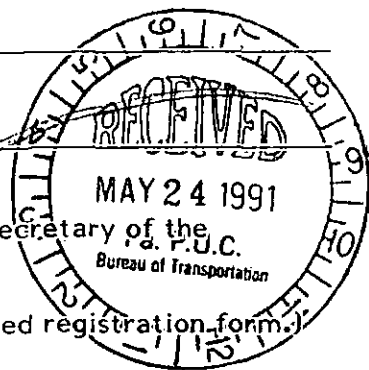

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AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between Moore's Hauling, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Transferor" and M & H Truck Rental, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Transferee", this 19th day of April, 1991.

WHEREAS, Transferor is a certificated common carrier by motor vehicle of persons, authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PA PUC) to perform transportation of property for hire at Docket A-98274; and

WHEREAS, Transferee is a Pennsylvania corporation which desires to purchase the PA PUC authority from Transferor; and

WHEREAS, Transferor is desirous of selling and transferring and Transferee is desirous of purchasing and receiving the PA PUC authority of Transferor:

WHEREFORE, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, and in consideration of their mutual covenants and agreements, hereby agree as follows:

1. (a) Transferor agrees to sell and transfer and Transferee agrees to purchase and receive the PA PUC authority of Transferor issued to it at Docket A-98274. Copies of Transferor's total PA PUC authority are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

(b) No other property is the subject of this Agreement.

(c) It is to be noted that there is no retention of authority by Transferor and therefore this transaction creates no duplication of authority nor fractionalization of authority.

2. The total consideration or purchase price to be paid by Transferee to Transferor for the sale and transfer of the aforementioned PA PUC authority is One Dollar (\$1.00).

3. (a) The consideration shall be paid after approval of the Commission of a transfer application to be filed with said Commission and at the time of consummation of this transaction.

(b) The reason that the consideration is nominal is that Wilma Moore, an individual, is sole shareholder and President of Transferor and Transferee. It is a business judgment and management decision to transfer the authority set forth in this agreement from one corporation to another. In addition, the various officers of Transferee are related family members to Wilma Moore.

4. Approval as used in this Agreement shall mean consent of the PA PUC to the application filed before such regulatory agency for transfer of the herein subject property from Transferor to Transferee, without any deletions and without any restrictions in the scope of authority or territory not now

existing. Any changes which are minor and do not effect the commodity scope or the territorial scope of the transferred authority, will not invalidate the Commission's approval of the transfer under the terms of this Agreement.

5. Consummation as used in this Agreement shall mean that date, after approval of the PA PUC as hereinbefore defined, that all monies due are paid over to Transferor and the Transferor executes any tariff adoption notice, if required by the Commission.

6. Consummation shall take place within thrity-five (35) days after receipt by counsel for Transferee of approval by the PA PUC of the transfer application and receipt by him of the Commission's tariff compliance instructions. The place of consummation shall be at said counsel's office, by mail or at any place mutually agreed upon by the parties.

7. It is understood and agreed that if the PA PUC shall fail to approve the transfer application filed before it, without willful action or neglect of Transferee, then this Agreement shall become null and void.

8. Transferor warrants and represents that there are no encumbrances or liens against the PA PUC authority herein proposed to be transferred nor will there be at the time of consummation; that there are no pending actions or proceedings which would jeopardize the aforesaid authority nor will there be at the time of consummation.

9. Transferee agrees that it will bear the financial obligation of the preparation of this Agreement between the parties; the preparation, filing and prosecution of the application before the PA PUC; and the consummation of the transaction. Transferee agrees to proceed promptly in the preparation, filing and prosecution of the application before the PA PUC.

10. Transferor agrees that it will fully cooperate in furnishing necessary information for the preparation of the Agreement and Application and will attend and furnish information pertaining to it at any hearing required and execute all necessary documents to fulfil the intent of this Agreement.

11. All parties will perform their respective obligations within a reasonable time to effectuate the intent of this Agreement.

12. This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.

13. This Agreement contains the entire Agreement between the parties concerning the subject hereof and may not be amended, supplemented or discharged, and no provisions hereof or thereof may be modified or waived, except expressly by an instrument in writing signed by the parties thereby affected.

14. Having been agreed to and made in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, this Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws thereof.

Application of MOORE'S HAULING, INC., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

REPORT AND ORDER  
APPROVING SERVICE AS A MOTOR CARRIER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter being before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission upon application of MOORE'S HAULING, INC., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, dated September 20, 1973, to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier, and having been duly presented in accordance with the rules of the Commission, and full investigation of the matters and things involved having been had, and it appearing that the rights granted herein are in effect a transfer of the rights which have been held by JAMES E. MOORE, trading and doing business as MOORE'S HAULING, under report and order issued at A. 94223 on February 26, 1968 and the certificate of public convenience issued thereunder, as modified and amended, which certificate will be subsequently cancelled as of the date of this order upon compliance with the tariff and insurance requirements of the Commission by MOORE'S HAULING, INC., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Commission finds and determines that approval of the application limited to the following rights:

1. To transport, as a Class D carrier, paper bags, paper rolls, cello products, cello rolls, plastic bags, and plastic film other than cellulose, for the Paramount Packaging Corporation, from points in the borough of Chalfont, Bucks County, to points in Pennsylvania, and the return of refused or damaged shipments to the points of origin.
2. To transport, as a Class D carrier, molded rubber products and flat sheets of rubber used in the manufacture of molded rubber products, for Surco, Inc., between points in the borough of Hatfield, Montgomery County, and from points in the said borough to points within an airline distance of fifty (50) statute miles of the limits of said borough, and vice versa;

and subject to the following conditions is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation or convenience of the public:

FIRST: That the service herein authorized is restricted to a pickup and delivery service, both to take place within a twelve (12) hour period.

SECOND: That the approval hereby given is not to be understood as committing the Commission, in any proceedings that may be brought before it for any purpose, to fix a valuation on the property or rights to be acquired by applicant from the present certificate holder equal to the consideration to be paid therefor, or equal to any value that may be placed thereon by applicant, or prescribe rates sufficient to yield a return thereon.

THIRD: That applicant shall not record in its utility accounts, any amount representing the rights herein granted, in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.

FOURTH: That the accounts of the transferee shall reflect the correct book values as the records of the transferor at the effective date of the transfer, any previously recorded appreciation having been deleted therefrom; provided that the applicant shall not record in its utility accounts any amounts representing the rights herein granted in excess of the actual cost of such rights to the original holder thereof.

FIFTH: That the certificate holder shall comply with all the provisions of the Public Utility Law as now existing or as may hereafter be amended, and revised General Order No. 29 effective July 1, 1939, or as may hereafter be revised, and any other rules and regulations as may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission. Failure to comply shall be sufficient cause to suspend, revoke or rescind the rights and privileges conferred by the certificate.

NOW, to wit, January 8, 1974, IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with the requirements of the Public Utility Law relating to insurance and the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates a certificate of public convenience issue evidencing the Commission's approval of the right to operate as above determined.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before thirty days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
