Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 54.32 and 62.105, this letter serves as notice to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") that the owners of HIKO Energy, LLC (HIKO) also have ownership interests in Alpha Gas & Electric, LLC (Alpha).

HIKO is licensed as an electric generation supplier (A-2012-2289944) and natural gas supplier (A-2012-2298532) in the Commonwealth. Alpha is licensed as an electric generation supplier (A-2011-2254554) and natural gas supplier (A-2013-2360403) in the Commonwealth.

Alpha is owned by Ketana Partners, LLC (Ketana) and Mr. David Wanounou. Ketana is a New York limited liability company with its principal place of business in Pomona, New York. Ketana is owned by Mr. Harvey Klein and Mr. Israel Orzel. Both Mr. Klein and Mr. Orzel own 10% or greater equity interest in HIKO.

The operations of HIKO are, and will be, separate from the operations of Alpha.

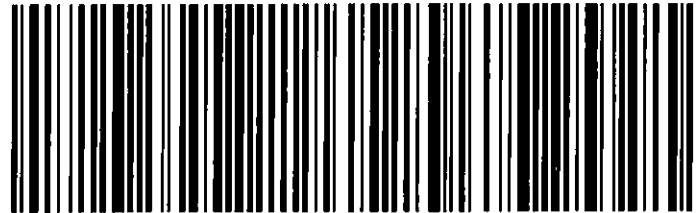
