 - Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis:
 - Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.

If the customer is unhappy with the auction results for any reason the customer may reschedule the auction.

EAH also intends to make the auction platform available to other brokers for their use. Brokers and Marketers may offer their customers a reverse auction. Brokers will be able to utilize our auction platform to offer this service-to their customers.

At this time EAH wishes to service commercial and industrial customers for both electricity and natural gas. We currently have no customers in other states. The auction platform and website are currently under construction and expect to be running by 12/15/13.

I. SUMMARY

In this Order, we license Energy Auction House, Inc. to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On August 22, 2013, Energy Auction House, Inc. (EAH) applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. EAH proposes to provide aggregator/broker service to the nonresidential customer classes throughout Maine. EAH met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements. As a licensed competitive electricity provider, EAH is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports. To the extent that a licensed competitive electricity provider uses third-parties to assist in obtaining customers during the course of its business, Chapter 305 § 4(C) of the Commission's rules places the responsibility on the competitive electricity provider for violations of the provisions of this section by representatives or agents acting on the CEP's behalf. Chapter 305 § 2(C)(3) also requires a competitive electricity provider to use reasonable efforts not to conduct business with any entity acting as a competitive electricity provider in Maine without a license from the Commission. Therefore, if EAH uses a third party, it is responsible to ensure that the third party has met any licensing requirements of the Commission.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S., § 3203 (1)(2) and Chapter 305, § 2 to license competitive electricity providers. On September 12, 2009, in Docket No. 2009-260, statutory changes took effect that change the title of this position. P.L. 2009, ch. 122. The Director of Technical Analysis is now the Director of Electric and Gas Utility




Deregulation

Deregulation separated the electricity business into three parts.


- Generation



Independent System Operator The electricity grid in deregulated states is monitored by an Independent System Operator (ISO). The ISO covering PA is PJM. The ISO ensures grid reliability and monitors the wholesale electricity market.



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Electricity Pricing

<u>Fixed</u> - customers contract a certain price per kilowatt hour for the duration of their contract. Each billing period their meter is read and the customer is billed their contract price times the number of kWh they used.

<u>Variable or Index</u> – Each billing period the customer's price is based on the wholesale price of electricity for that billing period plus an agreed upon adder or margin. The customer is charged the calculated price times the number of kWh used according to their meter read.

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Pricing Options

<u>Traditional</u>- EAH will submit customer information to various suppliers and receive pricing. EAH will compare offers and present the best to the customer.
