Dear Rosemary Chiavetta,

Referencing the above docket number, we formally register our complaint regarding the construction of the new electric transmission line, relevant to the proximity to our occupied property. Our attendance at public meetings assured us that the line could not be closer than 300 feet from our property, which should have eliminate the proposed route which passed our property due to the proximity of other buildings and structures. As this was one of three proposed routes, we considered the route passed our property as moot.

A representative from PP & L stopped at our home earlier this year and informed us that the new power line would, in fact, pass next to our property, and would be less than 300 feet. When I questioned him, he stated that he would mail me information. I received a brochure from PP & L real estate service which contained references to eminent domain. We protested earlier to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and were assigned case number 3051925 for investigation, of which this case should still be open. We do not feel being subjected to the negative affects regarding our personal safety, health, and property de-valuation is justified since alternative routes are available.

Please consider our plea, and request that PP & L explore their alternate routes.
