PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS OF APPLICANT DANACH LLC TO THE
PROTEST OF GERMANTOWN CAB CO.

Movant, Danach, LLC, by and through their attorney, David P. Temple, Esquire, hereby respectfully requests dismissal of the protest of Germantown Cab Co, for lack of standing in the Application before the Commission and in support thereof aver as follows:

1. Movant is Danach LLC who filed an Application with the Commission for authority to provide limousine service in the Counties of Montgomery, Bucks, Delaware and Chester to points in Pennsylvania and return, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority on or about October 16, 2013.
2. The Application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on December 7, 2013 with protests due on or before December 23, 2013. A true and correct copy of the publication is attached hereto as Exhibit A

3. On January 2, 2014 Respondent, Germantown Cab Co, filed a protest to this Application. A true and correct copy of the Commission docket is attached hereto as Exhibit B
4. Germantown Cab Co is a corporation registered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
5. The protest was a form protest citing objections based on allegations that the Applicant cannot meet the requirement of need.
6. There is no requirement to show need for a limousine applicant.
7. The Protest also makes a general assertion that the Applicant cannot meet its burden as to fitness and harm to the Protestant.
8. The Protestant cites no specific allegations as to how this Applicant does not meet the fitness requirements nor how the Protestant will be harmed in any way by granting of the Application
9. The protest was filed over one week past the filing deadline if December 23, 2013
10. The Application before the Commission seeks the following authority:

To transport persons in limousine service from points in the Counties of Montgomery, Bucks, Delaware and Chester, to points in Pennsylvania and return, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.
11. Respondent's authority is for the transportation of persons in call or demand.
12. Respondent attached the authority to his protest as required by the Commission. A true and correct copy of the protest including the authority is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

13. The type of service sought (limousine) in this Application is not within the authority of the Respondent.
14. Since the Protest herein was filed over one week after the end of the protest period the Protest is untimely.
15. Therefore the preliminary objection as to timeliness is valid and the protest must be dismissed.
16. Since the Protest fails to make specific allegations of how the Applicant does not meet fitness requirements of the Commission nor does it state in any way how the Protestant will be harmed by the granting of this Application, the Protest lacks both legal and factual specificity.
17. Therefore the preliminary objection as to the insufficient legal and factual specificity is valid and the protest must be dismissed.
18. Since the authority sought within this Application is not the same authority as possessed by the Protestant/Respondent, the Respondent therefore lacks standing to protest this Application.
19. Therefore the preliminary objection as to the lack of standing is valid and the Protest must be dismissed

WHEREFORE, Movant Danach LLC, by and through their attorney respectfully requests the Commission grant the preliminary objections of the Applicant Danach LLC

and order the dismissal of the protest of Germantown Cab Co to the Application of
Danach LLC under Docket No. A-2013-2391804

**MEMORANDUM OF LAW IN SUPPORT OF PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS OF
APPLICANT DANACH LLC TO THE PROTEST OF GERMANTOWN CAB CO**

THE PROTEST OF GERMANTOWN CAB CO IS INVALID AS IT WAS UNTIMELY
FILED

A protest shall be filed within the time frame specified in the published notice of the Application. 52 Pa.Code §5.53. The Application of Danach LLC was published in the December 7, 2013 Pennsylvania Bulletin. The Bulletin clearly noticed all interested parties that protests were to be filed and served on the Applicant by Monday December 23, 2013. A true and correct copy of the notice published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Protestant Germantown Cab Company filed their protest on January 2, 2014, a full week after the filing deadline. Since the protest was not filed by the time permitted under regulation, the Protest must be dismissed.

THE PROTESTANT LACKS THE REQUISITE STANDING TO MAINTAIN A
PROTEST AGAINST THE APPLICANT

To file and maintain a complaint a person must have a direct, immediate and substantial interest in the subject matter of the controversy. Waddington v. Pennsylvania Public Utility commission, 670 A. 2d 199 (Pa. Cmwlth. Ct. 1995, appeal denied 544 Pa.

697, 678 A.2d 368 (1996); Franklin Twp. V. PA. Dept. of Environmental Resources, 499 Pa. 162, 452 A.2d 718 (1982). Standing relates to the fact that a person who is not aggrieved by a matter cannot move to obtain a judicial resolution of his challenge. William Penn Parking Garage, Inc. v. City of Pittsburgh, 464 Pa. 168, 346 A.2d 269 (1975). Relative to the Protest of an Application before the Commission the Protestant must have some operating authority in actual or potential conflict with the authority sought by the Applicant to have the requisite standing to protest the Application. Application of Glen Alsace Water Company, 45 PaPUC 472 (1971). Call or demand authority conferred no standing to protest scheduled route service, Application of Ronald M. McDonald t/d/b/a Rusmin Trucking, A-00107696 F.2 (entered February 21, 1989). Furthermore in the case of Application of Commercial Aggregates Transportation and Sales, L.P. A-0011085, F0003 (entered June 22, 1994) a certificated common carrier was found to lack standing to continue the prosecution of a protest after a restrictive amendment eliminated all areas of operating authority between the protestant and the applicant. The controlling principle is that a protestant must have some operating authority in actual, or potential conflict with the authority sought by an applicant to have the requisite standing to protest the application. Re: Application of Unique Limousine, Inc., Docket A-00104709F0002AMA.

In this matter the Protestant is a call or demand carrier and has attached and identified that authority in his protest. The Applicant herein does not seek call or demand service, but rather limousine service. Since the Protestant does not have any authority in conflict with the authority sought by the Applicant he therefore lacks standing and should have his protest dismissed.

THE PROTEST IS LEGALLY DEFICIENT BECAUSE IT LACK THE SPECIFICITY
REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN A PROTEST

The PUC requires protestants to state their basis for protests very clearly and is not tolerant of boilerplate protest language. In the Application of Sean McDonough t/a Northstar Executive Transportation the Commission noted “ [A] one-page Protest contains little more than bald assertions that the Applicant has failed to satisfy the Commission's evidentiary criteria for approval of the Application. The Protestant offers no specific factual averments in support of his assertions. Rather than prolong this matter, the Protest will be dismissed and the Application will be granted without the portions of the restrictive amendment relating to equipment ((A)-(C)). PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION, 2002 Pa. PUC LEXIS 45 (November 21, 2002, Adopted; December 4, 2002, Entered). The Commission shows little tolerance for generally-worded protests that lack a factual basis. *See Re: Distrib. Freight Sys., Inc.*, 66 Pa. P.U.C. 231, 233 (1988); *Re: Ketron, Inc.*, 67 Pa. P.U.C. 394, 400 (1988) (“This type of generalized pleading in [an application] proceeding is not helpful to either the Commission or the public.”). *Id*

That is the exact scenario with this protest. The Protestant Germantown Cab Company is one of four different protests that are all identical in their language. Executive Transportation Company, Inc, Five Star Limousine Service Inc and Black Star Limousine, Inc have all made identical allegations. However none of these protests including this one is clear as to how the applicant does not meet the requirements of the PUC or how the Protestant will be harmed by the granting of this Application. The only

allegation is that Protestant objects “on the ground that Applicant cannot meet its burden under 52 Pa. Code §41.14 as to need, fitness and harm to Protestant.” There is no further development of that allegation. Such bald assertions cannot satisfy the requirements of a valid protest. Since the specificity required of a protest before the Commission does not exist, the Protest must be dismissed
