pay \$590.00, I had someone to lend me \$470.00

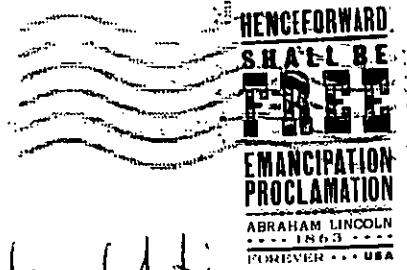
not \$590.00, that's when I contacted the P.U.C.
