
To whom it may concern,

From the documentation I received on 1/14/2014 states I'm disputing the chargers, which is not the case. I am disputing the payment arrangement I was placed on did not allow me to pay off the back balance. I was asked to pay over seven hundred dollars a month and none of that was place on my back balance and when I would ask where is the funds being applied to Peco customer service could not tell me. That when I became concern, because I have 2 children in the home. Peco customer service rep suggested, "I come off the arrange ment because it did not help my situation any, and contact the PUC, and see what they could do. I was receiving bills every other week with requesting different billing chargers and I didn't know which one to handle at the time. I never denied the charges the on the account, but wanted to know why I keep receiving invoices with different payment being requested. This was because of the heating source that was being used at that time. At that time my heating source was electric heaters, since then my heating system has changed to Philadelphia Gas works. Every time I received a bill I would contact Peco and the response I would get from customer service was they could not tell me anything but to make a payment and when I would ask how much they would say, "I don't know Ms. Samuel." All I wanted and still want is payment arrangement that will allow me to pay off the back balance of my account. At this point I'm confused and would like the opportunity to hire an attorney so at least I can have a chance to get the arrangement to pay for the usage I use and a set amount for my back balance.
