

Format: Answers to items of New Matter of Respondent, PECO Energy Company

1. There is not any proof that PECO was not negligent in this matter. There are no witnesses to PECO's claim that a 4x8 insulated sheathing flew off a truck and damaged their 34KV primary line. In an un-practical sense, the 4x4 piece of burnt insulation that was presented by PECO at the related Township Meeting, on 12/9/2013, weighed less than one pound. The insulation would have had to go up 35ft. in order to bring down the primary line. Also, on 11/05/13, some of our Township citizens were told by some on-site PECO workers that a tree limb was responsible. Also, PECO had been working on nearby power lines, one or two days prior to the surge on 11/5/2013.
2. My complaint does not seek the PUC to order PECO Energy to award me damages. I expect the PUC to make an impartial decision on PECO's negligence and accountability.
3. Complainant agrees as per stated within Item 2, above.
4. There is nothing to deny related to the Commission's jurisdiction. See Item 2, above.
