


Dear Judge Jones:

Unfortunately, I had to write to you before Friday's hearing about a problem we were unaware of when the hearing was rescheduled. I spoke with Ms. Morris on Wednesday around noon. Shortly after, to my surprise our 8 year old knocked on the door. I was shocked and found out the schools have half day conferences through Friday. Normally, I pick the kids up at the bus stop. I called the schools to confirm that conferences include this Friday.

We were not aware of the conference schedule until yesterday. Since receipt of this information until this morning, we tried to have our children stay with a schoolmate family until I returned but were unsuccessful. They were unavailable as families utilize the half day conference days and take off completely spending the time for vacation.

With the half days, our children start arriving on the bus at 11:50-12 noon. My wife works fulltime and we are greatly concerned about leaving the kids alone for several hours. If I attended the hearing, I would not return home no earlier than 2 p.m. on the train. Due to this situation, we do not want to leave the kids alone without adult supervision for two plus hours. I request to participate in the hearing by phone. I do not know what else to do or say. Thank you for your consideration to this request.
