JUSTIFICATION STATEMENT FOR INCREASES BY COMMON CARRIERS OF PROPERTY

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EXPLAIN BELOW THE REASON(S) FOR THIS PROPOSED INCREASE. CITE ANY UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

Applicant is seeking an increase in its hourly rates for shipments of household goods in use transported distances of forty (40) miles or less.

The last increase in applicants hourly rates took effect March 2, 2009 shown on 14th Revised Page 74 to Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 (50-T) issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent. Appli

Applicant has decided to file this proposed increase in hourly rates as an exception versus a "county" rate. Remaining Tristate movers who participate in Transportation Rate Table JJ in Tariff 50 want to maintain the current level which is counter productive for your applicant.

The proposed increase amounts to \$53,296 determined by 5.6% increase times \$951,717.representing 100% of it Pa. revenuees.

The primary justification for seeking an increase in its hourly rates include:

- (1) \$10,001 More income continuing being used by older equipment causing breakdowns.
- (2) \$20,003 Increase in wages for drivers and helpers.
- (4) \$8,575 Website purchasing additional leads.
- (5) \$9,700 W/C claims increasing
- (6) \$38,550 Owner David Fusina working at the moving company and held another job as a buniness analyst for a a large company that just terminated his position making it necessary with only income from the moving company to be increased to survive.

The project operating ratio will climb from 94.1% to 97.0% as the as the applicant can only file for the increase at this level to avoid being non-competitive.
