NOTE 4 - WAIVER OF MINIMUM CHARGES - CARRIER CONVENIENCE: carrier shall not assess a minimum charge (number of hours) whenever a move requires less than the minimum number of hours filed. And said move is performed solely at the carriers convenience. In such instances the carrier shall charge based on the actual time to complete move plus applicable travel charge.

NOTE AA - A travel charge will apply on all local residential moves in an amount to be determined as follows:

- (a) When the point of origin and the point of final destination are within fifteen (15) air miles of carrier's facility, the travel charge shall be based on one (1) hour at the applicable hourly rates.
- (b) When the point of origin is within fifteen (15) air miles of carrier's facility and the point of final destination is in excess of fifteen (15) air miles but less than twenty-five (25) air miles, the travel charge shall be based on 1.5 hours at the applicable hourly rate (or vice versa).
- (c) When the point of origin is within fifteen (15) air miles of carrier's facility and the point of final destination is in excess of twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility, the travel charge shall be based on two (2) hours at the applicable hourly rate (or vice versa).
- (d) When the point of origin is in excess of fifteen (15) air miles but less than twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility and the point of final destination is in excess of fifteen (15) air miles but less than twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility, the travel charge shall be based on 1.5 hours at the applicable hourly rate (or vice versa).
- (e) When the point of origin is in excess of fifteen (15) air miles but less than twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility and the point of final destination is in excess of twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility, the travel charge shall be based on two (2) hours at the applicable hourly rate (or vice versa).
- (f) When the point of origin is in excess of twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility and the point of final destination is in excess of twenty-five (25) air miles of carrier's facility, the travel charge shall be based on two (2) hours at the applicable hourly rate.
