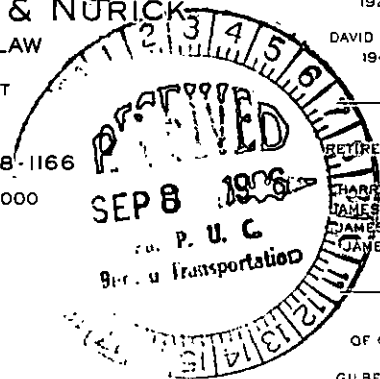

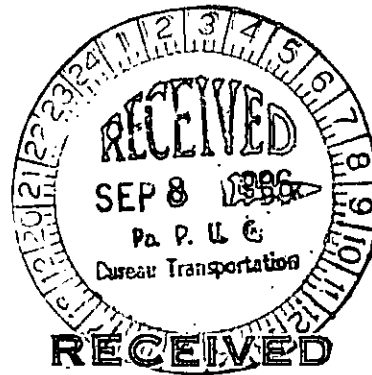

AGREEMENT OF SALE

5

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Sept., 1986, by and between J. Edward Clouse of Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as "Transferor"), and Clouse Trucking, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation, having its principal office at Carlisle, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as "Transferee"),

W I T N E S S E T H :

1. Transferor agrees to sell, assign and transfer to Transferee, and Transferee agrees to buy, Transferor's intra-state operating authority issued by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") issued at Docket No. A-90287 (hereinafter referred to as "operating authority"), as set forth in Appendix "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Transferee agrees to pay to Transferor the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) for the operating authority.

3. Transferor and Transferee acknowledge that this agreement is subject to approval by the Commission and agree to join promptly in making an application to the Commission for approval of this transaction. Transferor, pending the consummation of this transaction, shall continue to maintain normal service between points and within the territory as authorized in the authority which is the subject of this transaction.

ATTACHMENT 1

4. Settlement shall take place at a time mutually agreed upon by the parties within thirty (30) days after approval of the application by the Commission.

5. This agreement supersedes and cancels all other or previous agreements, options, or understandings by, between, or among the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter herein.



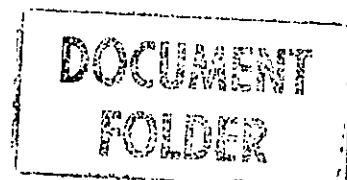

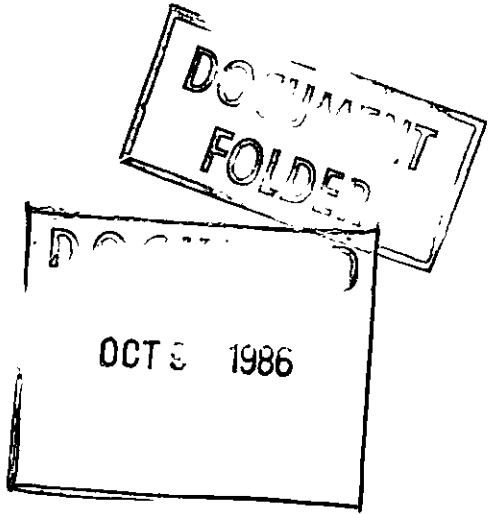
