The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) files this Notice of Intervention with respect to the filing by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL” or the “Company”) of Supplement 139 to its Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 (“Supplement 139”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on October 22, 2013. Supplement No. 139 reflects an interim adjustment to PPL Electric’s Act 129-1 Compliance Rider (“ACR-1”) and according to the Company is designed to avoid a significant ACR-1 over/undercollection.


