



**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM  
OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION**

TO: ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE SUSAN D. COLWELL:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or “Company”) hereby submits this Prehearing Conference Memorandum in compliance with the Prehearing Conference Order issued by Administrative Law Susan D. Colwell (the “ALJ”) on March 11, 2014.

**I. BACKGROUND**

On October 22, 2013, PPL Electric filed Supplement No. 139 to Tariff – Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 (“Supplement 139”) modifying the Company’s Act 129 Compliance Rider – Phase 1 (“ACR-1”), with an issuance date of October 22, 2013, and an effective date of November 1, 2013. Supplement No. 139 was assigned Docket No. M-2013-2389549. Also on October 22, 2013, PPL Electric filed Supplement No. 140 to Tariff – Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 (“Supplement 140”) modifying the Company’s Act 129 Compliance Rider – Phase 2 (“ACR-2”), with an issuance date of October 22, 2013, and an effective date of November 1, 2013. Supplement No. 140 was assigned Docket No. M-2013-2389551.

By Secretarial Letter dated October 31, 2013, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) permitted Supplement Nos. 139 and 140 to become effective on November 1, 2013. On November 1, 2013, the PP&L Industrial Customer Alliance (“PPLICA”) filed a letter with the Commission reserving its rights to file a Complaint or take other action following further review of PPL Electric’s tariff supplements.

On December 27, 2013, the Commission served PPL Electric with the two above-captioned PPLICA complaints. On January 16, 2014, PPL Electric filed answers to the PPLICA complaints.

A Prehearing Conference Order was issued on March 11, 2014, scheduling a prehearing conference on March 26, 2014, and directing that the parties submit prehearing memoranda on or before March 21, 2014.

On March 21, 2014, the Office of Small Business Advocate filed a Notice of Intervention and Public Statement
