

**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
THE COLUMBIA INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS**

Pursuant to Sections 5.71 through 5.74 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Regulations, 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71 - 5.74, the Columbia Industrial Intervenors ("CII") hereby file this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, CII asserts as follows:

1. For purposes of this proceeding, CII includes the companies listed in Appendix "A" hereto. CII will update Appendix "A" during the course of this proceeding as needed to reflect changes in its membership.

3. On February 26, 2014, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia" or "Company") filed with the Commission Supplement No. 210 to Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 9

("Supplement No. 210"). Supplement No. 210 proposes a Pilot Rider New Area Service ("NAS") offering an alternative approach to any residential applicant or bona fide developer who would be required to provide a deposit under Rule No. 8 – Extensions Rule of Columbia's tariff for an extension of the Company's distribution facilities.

4. CII is an ad hoc group of energy-intensive customers receiving service from Columbia under both sales and transportation rate schedules, including Rate LDS (Large Distribution Service) and Rate LGSS (Large General Sales Service). CII members use substantial volumes of natural gas in their manufacturing and operational processes, and natural gas costs comprise a significant element of their respective costs of operation. Any modification to Columbia's rates and terms of service may have a significant impact on CII members' cost of doing business.


5. As set forth in Supplement No. 210, Pilot Rider NAS would be applicable throughout Columbia's service territory "for any residential customer . . . or commercial and industrial customers" Accordingly, the Commission's resolution of these issues may impact CII members.

6. Therefore, consistent with 52 Pa. Code § 5.72(a), CII has a significant interest in this proceeding that is not represented by any other party of record. Consequently, CII should be granted intervenor status in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Columbia Industrial Intervenors respectfully request that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission grant this Petition to Intervene and provide the Columbia Industrial Intervenors with full-party status in this proceeding.
