Dear Secretary Chiavatta:

By Order entered August 29, 2013 the Commission granted the natural gas supplier (NGS) application for North American Power and Gas, LLC ("NAPG") to serve residential, small commercial, large commercial, industrial, and governmental customers within the following local distribution company service territories within the Commonwealth: Equitable Gas Company's, UGI Utilities, Inc.), , National Fuel Gas Corp., , PECO Energy Company-Gas, and Peoples Natural Gas Company.

The purpose of this letter is to request approval for NAPG to amend its NGS license to expand its services to small commercial, commercial, industrial and governmental customers in the services territories of, , Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania Inc. ("CPA") and. In support of this request, NAPG is enclosing documentation to evidence NAPG's compliance with the Section 2008(c) bonding requirement for CPA's proposed service territories, at this time, CPA does not require a bond, and however, we have attached the letter of credit worthiness approving our financial qualifications to serve in CPA's service territories.

On March 11, 2014 (at the time NAPG filed its application), NAPG published notice of its intent to render service throughout Pennsylvania in the following newspapers: The Patriot-News and Williamsport Sun-Guzette. A copy of this proof of publication is also enclosed herein.

Specifically, the notice stated as follows (emphasis added):

*Application of **North American Power and Gas, LLC** For Approval To Offer, Render, Furnish Natural Gas Supply Services as a **Supplier Engaged In The Business Of Supplying Natural Gas Supply Services, To The Public In The Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania, Docket No. A-2013-2353838**. On **May 15, 2013**, **North American Power and Gas** filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for a license to provide natural gas supply services as a supplier of natural gas engaged in the business of supplying natural gas, and (3) an aggregator engaged in the business of providing natural gas supply services. **North American Power and Gas** proposes to sell natural gas and related services throughout all of Pennsylvania under the provisions of the new Natural Gas Choice and Competition Act. The PUC may consider this application without a hearing. Protests directed to the technical or financial fitness of **North American Power and Gas** may be filed within 15 days of the date of this notice with the Secretary of the PUC, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265. You should send copies of any protest to **Company's Name, ATTN: Christina Gelo** at the address listed below. Please include the PUC's "docket number" on any correspondence, which is **A-2013-2353838**.*



22. **FURTHER DEVELOPMENTS:** Applicant is under a continuing obligation to amend its application if substantial changes occur in the information upon which the Commission relied in approving the original filing.
23. **FALSIFICATION:** The Applicant understands that the making of false statement(s) herein may be grounds for denying the Application or, if later discovered, for revoking any authority granted pursuant to the Application. This Application is subject to 18 Pa. C.S. §§4903 and 4904, relating to perjury and falsification in official matters.
24. **FEE:** The Applicant has enclosed the required initial licensing fee of \$350.00 payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
