
This is to request an extension of time in which to file a Reply to the Complainant's Exceptions which are dated March 17, 2014 but, as evidenced by the Certificate of Service, the Complainant did not place a copy of the Exceptions in the mail to PGW until March 28, 2014. PGW did not receive the copy placed in the mail until March 31, 2014. The Complainant did not perfect service by e-mail.

The Commission issued its Initial Decision in this matter on February 26, 2014. Thus, any exceptions to the Initial Decision were to be filed by March 18, 2014. Reply exceptions were due by March 28, 2014. A review of the Commission record reveals that it accepted the Complainant's exceptions which are dated March 17, 2014. But these are not accompanied by a Certificate of Service.

On Monday, March 31, 2014, PGW received the Complainant's exceptions, a copy of which is attached. These are accompanied by Certificate of Service dated Friday, March 28, 2014. Thus, PGW was not aware of the filing of exceptions until March 31, 2014, three days after the due date for Reply exceptions. Therefore, PGW requests that it be permitted to file reply exceptions by April 10, 2014

I gave my permission and I was approved for liheap. I was told by a representative that I would be put on that crisis list. I later found out this did not happen. A formal complaint was filled against PGW by myself Willie Clark. When I was sent a hearing date it stated on the document that the PUC promotes settlements and that someone from PGW would be contacting me within 10 days before the hearing date. No one contacted me, to negotiate by mail or by phone. So I called PGW. Thinking the amount in question \$1,254.44 was added into my CRP amount I was satisfied, so on Feb.04, 2014 I submitted a letter to Administrative Law Judge Christopher Pell and PGW Laure to Farinas esq. withdrawing my formal complaint. This was a mistake, because I was later informed that I still owe that amount with no agreements. I do believe I was misinformed.


