On March 21, 2014, PECO Energy received a carbon copy of email correspondence from the Complainant, Paul Kopanycia directed to Your Honor requesting to withdraw the above-referenced matter. 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) states:

Except as provided in subsection (b), a party desiring to withdraw a pleading in a contested proceeding may file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document with the Commission and serve it upon the other parties.
