INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

By this application, Debo Moving and Storage, Inc. (Debo or Applicant) seeks

authority as follows:

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To transport household goods in use between points in the County of Mercer, and from points in said County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

This application is unopposed. Applicant submits herewith its verified statements in support of the application.

VERIFIED STATEMENT OF BRIAN K. DEBO ON BEHALF OF DEBO MOVING AND STORAGE, INC.

1. Legal name and Domicile of Applicant

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Applicant is Debo Moving and Storage, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation domiciled at 1508 B State Street West, Baden, Beaver County, PA 15005.

2. Identity and Qualifications of Person Making Statement

My name is Brian K. Debo. My business office location is 1508 B State Street West, Baden, Beaver County, PA 15005, and my business mailing address P.O. Box 278, New Brighton, Beaver County, PA 15066. My phone number is (724) 869-9555. I am the President and principal shareholder of the Applicant and have been since its inception. I am authorized to make this statement on behalf of Debo Moving and Storage, Inc. (Debo or Applicant) before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

3. Applicant's Affiliations

Neither the Applicant nor any of its officers, directors or shareholders, has any ownership or management interest in any other transport carrier.

4. Authority Sought

By this application, Debo seeks the following operating authority as published

in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*:

To transport household goods in use between points in the County of Mercer, and from points in said County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

5. General Scope of Currently Authorized Operations

Debo is presently authorized to transport household goods in use pursuant to authority issued by this Commission. Debo is authorized to transport household goods and office furnishings in use, between points in Beaver County, and from points in Beaver County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa. Debo is also authorized to transport household goods and office furnishings in use from various points in the County of Allegheny, to points in Pennsylvania, and between points in the County of Allegheny. A summary of Debo's authority is attached to my statement as Appendix "A".

6. Duplicating Authority Which Will Result From Grant of Authority

Very little duplicating authority will result from approval of this application. Debo does not currently hold statewide authority to transport household goods in use to or from Mercer County. Its authority to serve Mercer County is limited to the right to provide service from points in Beaver and Allegheny Counties to points in Pennsylvania.

7. Terminal Facilities and Communications Network

Debo has its office and warehouse in Baden, Beaver County, PA. Our climate controlled warehouse facility is 43,000 square feet. Approximately 39,000 square feet are used for household goods storage; the remaining 4,000 square feet are used as office space. The warehouse is of steel and concrete construction. It has a sprinkler system and a 24-hour monitored fire and security system. The warehouse is inspected 2-3 times per year by the Department of Defense and is presently used for civilian and government storage. Debo employs a full-time

warehouseman/maintenance man who oversees warehouse operations along with the dispatcher.

Drivers receive their daily assignments from the office. There is communication with the office throughout the day via the telephone. Communication between the office and employees is maintained by a supervisor who accompanies the crew on the job assignment. If a supervisor is not available, a designated person in charge maintains contact with the office.

8. Equipment

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There is attached to my statement as Appendix "B" a list of the equipment to be operated by Debo upon approval of this application. Each piece of equipment is described as follows: type of equipment, year and model, PA Apportion or PA license number, and general description of the features of the equipment. All equipment is owned by the Applicant. All drivers employed are both movers and packers. There are additional employees who are trained to pack only. The movers and packers help with maintenance of the warehouse as well as the cleaning and maintenance of the vehicles.

9. Safety Program

Safety plays an important role in our daily operations. The following is a brief description of these programs.

- a. Employees attend an initial skills and certification class which addresses practical safety rules. Upon completion, a test is administered on the information presented at the class.
- b. Employees attend quarterly meetings that focus on safety issues.

c. Pre-trip inspection forms are also utilized to ensure safety. The drivers are required to fill out the form and return it to the office daily. Drivers are also required to fill out a form indicating any repairs and/or mechanical defects experienced on their truck.

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- d. We are extremely persistent with the professional maintenance of our vehicles. We spend approximately \$40,000.00 per year on equipment maintenance.
- e. A complete bi-annual Department of Transportation safety inspection is done on all vehicles.
- f. All drivers are required to take a pre-qualification drug test and a physical. Renewal physicals are every two (2) years and random drug testing is performed throughout the year.
- g. We have a program for new hires through our Workman's Compensation carrier. The program tests an individual's physical capabilities for the moving and/or packing positions. This program is designed to eliminate unnecessary injury to an employee and his crew members.
- h. We offer a formal ongoing training class for all of our employees. Each person must successfully complete this training course to be employed at Debo. Two (2) of our employees are certified instructors of this training series. The course utilizes videos, handouts, group discussion, and field training. Written tests are given throughout this program.
- i. Our orientation program provides an overview of our industry and concentrates on employee work related problems and the attitude, ability, and appearance of our employees.
- j. Training involves thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction for packing and (30) hours for moving. In addition, there are 200 hours of field training for each packer and mover certificate. Both classroom instruction and field training are monitored and graded. Upon completion of the training program, an employee will have a total of 460 hours of training.

10. Service Currently Provided to Supporting Witnesses

Debo has been providing the transportation of household goods and household

goods storage for many years. Precautions are taken to preserve the condition of the

household goods held for storage. Precautions include padding furniture and shrink wrapping sofas and large overstuffed items.

Most of our sales are completed over the telephone. We advertise in numerous telephone directories and we advertise in the Mercer and Lawrence County Yellow Book. A copy of the listing we have in Mercer County is attached hereto as Appendix "C". We utilize a computer program for questioning potential customers to gain information needed to provide an accurate estimate. The field salesmen use pre-typed forms and sales folders to present their information. They calculate the weight of the shipment by using the table of measurements and calculate the cost by using the tariff.

Due to our advertising in various telephone directories, we have had requests for service outside of the boundaries in which we have authority. We have received requests for service in Mercer County, but we have not heretofore kept records of such calls. Attached as Appendix "D" is a list of interstate moves we have handled from Mercer County and one move from Mercer County to our storage site. Our application is unopposed and we would like to offer intrastate service upon issuance of the license.

11. Type of Service Offered

Debo desires to provide services to transport household goods in use between points in Mercer County and from points in Mercer County to points in Pennsylvania. Debo has determined there is a need for such services based on the requests that we have received. We have the equipment and personnel available to expand this service to provide transportation services to a larger geographic area. Our business hours are Monday through Friday 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Dispatch and operations hours are extended beyond normal business hours on a demand basis. We are closed on Sundays and the six major holidays a year.

12. Financial Data

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There is attached to my statement as Appendix "E", a copy of the financial statements of the Applicant, which includes a list of assets, liabilities as of the latest available date.

My name and business address are L. DeWitt Boosel, 80 Jefferson Avenue, Sharon, PA 16146. I am the Executive Director of the Mercer County Housing Authority located in Sharon, Mercer County, PA.

The Mercer County Housing Authority manages 774 apartments in 14 public housing communities located in small towns or rural settings across Mercer County. This number, combined with 238 section 8 and 12 Shelter Plus Care vouchers, brings our total to 1,024 units.

The Mercer County Housing Authority currently is in the process of moving approximately 60 families as a result of a Federally Funded HOPE VI revitalization effort in public housing. Approximately 98% of the moves would involve transportation within Mercer County.

It is in the best interest of the public to be able to utilize a competitive bidding process. In regards to Mercer County Housing Authority's possible future moving needs, we would support additional carriers authorized to be able to work with the Authority should that need arise.

We request that full consideration be given for additional carriers to be authorized to provide household goods transportation service between points in Mercer County and from points in Mercer County to points in Pennsylvania vice versa. We attempted to obtain the services of a household goods carrier through a competitive bid process. In the year 2002, we received competitive bids from three carriers, including the applicant, Debo Moving and Storage. None of the carriers that submitted bids were certificated to provide the transportation of household goods in Mercer County at the time the bids were submitted. As a result of being the lowest bidder, we supported the application of Houston H. Pincham, d/b/a H.H. Pincham Moving Company, for emergency and permanent authority. Federal and State law requires Mercer County Housing Authority to solicit bids and when no certified companies bid it presents a problem.

STATEMENT OF MICHELLE TRENT



My name and address are Michelle Trent, 29 Dogwood Lane, Grove City, PA 16127. My husband, Craig Trent, and I and our children have resided at 29 Dogwood Lane for 5-1/2 years. We have resided in Mercer County for 7 years.

When we moved our residence to Dogwood Lane 5-1/2 years ago from another point in Grove City, we were unable to obtain the services of a local mover. Although we were familiar with Debo Moving and Storage and knew of its reputation as a capable and responsible mover, we were unable to use the services of Debo because it did not have operating rights to provide local moves within Mercer County.

Although my husband, and l, have no present plans to move in the foreseeable future, it is possible that we may move again from our residence in Grove City which is in Mercer County. If we did move again, we would want to use the services of Debo because of our familiarity with the owner and our knowledge of its superior and quality service. We are not aware of any local mover serving Mercer County, but we are familiar with Debo and we believe there is a need for the services of Debo in Mercer County.

Debo Moving and Storage moved my parents between Beaver and Chippewa, located in Beaver County, in March of this year. Debo actually placed the furniture of my parents in storage in September 2001, and moved the furniture to their new residence in Chippewa in March 2002. The services Debo provided were excellent. We would like to have those services available to us in Mercer County as well.

Mercer County is a growing area. There is a large outlet mall in Grove City that has attracted new residents and Mercer County has become the domicile of many persons who actually work in the City of Pittsburgh and commute to and from Mercer County. My husband is a physician and knows of other physicians who have relocated to Mercer County but who also practice in Pittsburgh or Allegheny County. We believe the growth of Mercer County warrants the authorization of an additional moving company to serve our communities in Mercer County.

My husband and I urge the PUC to grant additional authority to Debo to provide service between points in Mercer County, and from points in Mercer County to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa. Debo is an excellent moving company and should be certificated to serve Mercer County to meet the needs of its residents and businesses having a need for the services of a moving company.
