#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed December 21, 2001. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of February 2, 2002. No protests were filed.

The unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of a verified statement entered by the applicant and two supporting statements.



#### **DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS:**

Brian K. Debo, President of Debo Moving and Storage, Inc. (Debo or applicant) is authorized to give the statement on behalf of the applicant. The applicant is now authorized to provide household goods in use transportation between various points in western Pennsylvania, subject to certain conditions. Debo seeks to expand its operating authority into Mercer County. Applicant's business office is located at 1508 B Street West, Baden, Beaver County. A warehouse facility at this address has 39,000 square feet of space available for household goods storage.

Debo has been authorized to provide household goods in use transportation in Pennsylvania since April 11, 1986. Over the years, the applicant has been granted additional authority to expand its service territory. As a presently certificated carrier, there is a presumption of fitness. The applicant has twenty-eight pieces of equipment available for use in the proposed expansion of territory.

L. DeWitt Boosel, Executive Director of the Mercer County Housing Authority (MCHA) has entered a support statement. He states that MCHA manages over 1,024 units of housing in Mercer County. At this time, approximately 60 families are in the process of moving and that 98% of the moves would involve transportation within Mercer County. MCHA wants to be able to utilize a competitive bidding process in securing transportation services.

Michelle Trent, Grove City, supports the application and would use Debo's service if she and her family would need a mover. She states that 5 ½ years ago, when they last moved, she was unable to obtain services of a local mover and could not use the applicant because it lacked the operating authority.

#### After complete review of the record, we find:

- 1. The applicant has the equipment, experience and fitness to provide the proposed service.
- 2. Approval of the unopposed application, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; **THEREFORE**,

IT IS ORDERED: That the unopposed application, be and is hereby approved so that the certificate issued April 11, 1986 shall be further amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, household goods in use, between points in the county of Mercer, and from points in said county, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not provide any service granted in this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:

A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the applicant, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event the applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
