SECTION 1  
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS IN USE, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), loose-leaf revisions thereto and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see governing tariff.

ITEM 30 - PACKING AND UNPACKING (#)

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 100), and such labor will be charged at labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300.

ITEM 40 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by, the householder.

ITEM 50 - PIANO CARRY CHARGES (#)

When piano and other heavy articles (weighing in excess of 300 pounds) are part of a shipment, carrier will assess the following charges in addition to the applicable hourly rates published herein.

SECTION 1  
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 60 - RIGGING, HOISTING OR LOWERING (#)

When it is necessary to use rigging, hoisting or lowering services in order to accomplish pickup or delivery of a shipment, carrier will perform such services at the following rates.

A flat charge of \$50.00 (first two articles) and \$25.00 for each additional article after first two articles.

ITEM 70 - FLIGHT CARRY CHARGE - PIANOS AND HEAVY ARTICLES (#)

When flight carry service of pianos and heavy articles (weighing in excess of 300 pounds) is provided, the following charges shall apply.

(a) Inside a building, the first flight shall consist of a total of at least eight (8) steps. Additional flights shall be defined as the number of complete floors above or below the first flight.

(b) Outside a building, the number of flights shall be determined based on the total number of steps as follows:

8 to 17 steps inclusive - 1 flight  
18 to 37 steps inclusive - 2 flights  
38 to 57 steps inclusive - 3 flights  
58 to 77 steps inclusive - 4 flights

(c) A charge of \$50.00 per flight per article.

SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 40) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charge on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Note 5 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

Note 1: Traveling charges (Note 5) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

Note 2: Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, as indicated during which services are performed.

Note 3: Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are computed in half-hour periods; fractions of a half-hour are considered one half-hour.

Note 4: Rates in Column 3 apply only from 5:01 P.M. to 12:00 midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.

Note 5: A flat charge based on the applicable transportation rate shown in Columns 2, 3 and 4 will be assessed to cover traveling charges to and from the job.

Over 0 not over 5 miles ..... 1/2 hour  
Over 5 not over 20 miles ..... 1 hour.  
Over 20 not over 30 miles ..... 1-1/2 hours.  
Over 30 not over 40 miles ..... 2 hours.

Note 6: Minimum Charge: Columns 2 and 3 hourly rates subject to a four (4) hour charge plus applicable traveling charge. Column 4 hourly rates subject to a two (2) hour charge plus applicable traveling charge.
