**INTRODUCTION**

Duquesne Light is a duly incorporated Pennsylvania public utility engaged in the distribution of electric service to the public, primarily within Allegheny and Beaver Counties, Pennsylvania, in an area of approximately 800 square miles having a combined population based on the 2000 census of approximately 1,327,057.

## DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED LINE

4. Duquesne Light proposes to convert a 20,200 foot segment of an existing 69 kilovolt ("kV") transmission line into a 138 kV transmission line. This 138 kV line will be identified as the "Cheswick-North tap to California Substation" ("Line"). The Line will tap the existing Cheswick-North, Z55, 138 kV line at Tower #706 and connect it to the new California Substation site. A topographic map of the area showing the location of the Line is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 1.

5. The Line will replace an existing tap between the Colfax-Pine Creek line, circuit #66113, Tower #1836 and the idle Edgewater Steel Customer Substation. This existing 69 kV line consists mainly of wood poles, but also includes two steel poles and two steel river crossing towers. The proposed Line tap at Tower #706 is directly adjacent to the existing 69 kV tap at Tower #1836; both towers are on Duquesne Light property. The new California Substation will be constructed in the same location and replace the existing Edgewater Steel Customer Substation.

6. The Line will require the replacement of approximately 75 poles with either wood or steel poles. The existing poles will be replaced with larger poles. The poles will be directly embedded. The height of the poles will range between 60 feet and 75 feet above the ground. The typical span length will remain the same, varying between 200 feet to 300 feet. The maximum span length will remain the same, 1,400 feet at the Allegheny River crossing. One existing river crossing tower will remain. The other existing tower on the substation side of the river, will be replaced with a steel pole as part of the purchase agreement with the underlying property owner; Duquesne Light now owns the underlying property.

7. The Line will be a three-phase alternating current transmission line. It will consist of three phase conductors and one shield wire. Each phase conductor will be an 853.7 kcmil 24/13 Aluminum Conductor Alloy Reinforced ("ACAR") conductor. The shield wire will be a 7 No. 8 Alumoweld ("ALWD") conductor. A cross-sectional

diagram showing the arrangement of the poles is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit 2.

8. Construction of the Line will take place in the following sequence:

- (1) The right-of-way will be cleared to accommodate the construction and provide electrical clearances for the operation of the completed Line;
- (2) Construction vehicles will enter the right-of-way to auger the holes and install the wood or steel poles;
- (3) After installation of the necessary insulators, guys, grounding and other hardware on each pole, the conductors will be installed and the Line connected to existing Tower #706 and to the substation terminal at the California Substation.

#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED ROUTE OF THE LINE**

9. The Line will tap into the existing Cheswick-North, Z55, 138 kV line beginning at Tower #706 in Indiana Township and will proceed a distance of 3.83 miles in a generally southeasterly direction, through Harmar Township, Fox Chapel Borough and O'Hara Township before crossing the Allegheny River and ending at the new California Substation in Oakmont Borough, Allegheny County. Approximately 3,090 feet of the Line is within Indiana Township, 6,260 feet is within Harmar Township, 3,820 feet is within Fox Chapel Borough, 6,380 feet is within O'Hara Township and approximately 650 feet of the Line is within Oakmont Borough, Allegheny County. Approximately 78 % of the Line will be located on existing 30-foot rights-of-way while 14 % will be located on existing centerline rights-of-way. Approximately 5 % will be located by railroad and river crossing permits and the remaining 3% will be located on Duquesne Light property.

#### **STATEMENT OF NEED**

10. In order to continue to supply O'Hara Township, Fox Chapel Borough and Oakmont Borough with reliable energy, a new 138 – 23 kV substation is required. Pine Creek Substation, which supplies O'Hara Township and Fox Chapel Borough, has

reached its operating limit. Logans Ferry Substation, which supplies Oakmont Borough, is approaching its operating limit, which may require the installation of a third 50 mVA transformer . As these areas continue to grow, maximum loading on both the individual distribution circuits and the major bulk supply substations will occur. The proposed California Substation will alleviate these load problems and improve the circuit reliability in the area. Some of the existing circuits are significantly longer than normal and therefore restoration time is increasing. Establishment of a new 138 – 23 kV substation will greatly improve service restoration time by cutting circuit exposure by approximately 50%. To summarize, this upgrade will result in the following:

- (1) Eliminate older 4 kV circuits.
- (2) Eliminate overloads on existing 13.2/23 kV circuits by establishing new 13.2/23 kV circuits at the new California Substation.
- (3) Eliminate overloads on Pine Creek Substation by transferring portions of distribution load to California Substation.
- (4) Eliminate the need for the installation of the third 50 mVA transformer at Logans Ferry Substation.
- (5) Improve circuit reliability by reducing circuit length and thereby reducing circuit exposure.

#### **BACKGROUND**

11. Duquesne Light performs an annual Reliability Benchmarking Study. This study is conducted by SGS Statistical Services, LLC, which is located in Tucson, Arizona. This service provides reliability information to 46 Electric Utilities across the United States. The study incorporates system outage averages, trend charts, Six-Sigma screening and performance points to analyze circuits. The study indicates that a significant number of the worse performing circuits in the Duquesne Light system originate from both Pine Creek and Logans Ferry Substations. These two substations and some of the circuits supplied by the substations would be relieved by the

proposed California Substation. The loading and reliability of the area would be greatly improved with the installation of the California Substation.

#### **SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS**

12. The Line will be designed, constructed, operated and maintained to meet or exceed the requirements of the 2002 edition of the NESC. The safety standards contained in the NESC relating to overhead electric supply lines have been incorporated into the design of the proposed Line as minimum safety standards as to required clearances and structural loadings. The design, construction, operation and maintenance procedures for this project will conform to Duquesne Light's transmission and distribution construction standards and Duquesne Light's procedures for erosion and sedimentation control, storm water management, and line clearance and vegetation management on rights-of-way. These standards meet or exceed all relevant NESC standards and all standards of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration.

#### **CONSTRUCTION COMMENCEMENT AND IN-SERVICE DATES**

13. The anticipated construction commencement date of the project is June 2005; the proposed in-service date for the Line is June, 2006.

#### **SERVICE OF LETTER OF NOTIFICATION**

14. Copies of this Letter of Notification have been sent to all interested parties by certified mail, return receipt requested, as required by Commission Regulation 57.74, 52 Pa. Code § 57.74.

#### **LETTER OF NOTIFICATION IN LIEU OF FULL SITING APPLICATION**

15. Commission Regulation 57.72(d)(1)(iv), 52 Pa. Code §57.72(d)(1)(iv), provides:

A letter of notification may be filed with the Commission in lieu of the application process set forth in §§ 57.72-57.76 for the following:


(iv) A line for which the voltage is proposed to be increased above its present levels, so long as the size, character, design or configuration of the proposed HV line does not substantially alter the right-of-way.

16. The Line, which is the subject of this Letter of Notification, will not substantially alter the right-of-way. The existing right-of-way agreements are written for a "transmission system for the conveyance and distribution of electric current". The route of the transmission line will remain unchanged. The existing rights-of-way widths, either 30 foot or centerline, will remain unchanged. The poles will be replaced one for one.

**RELIEF REQUESTED**

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is requested that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission grant Duquesne Light Company approval to proceed with the construction of the proposed Line as described in this Letter of Notification.

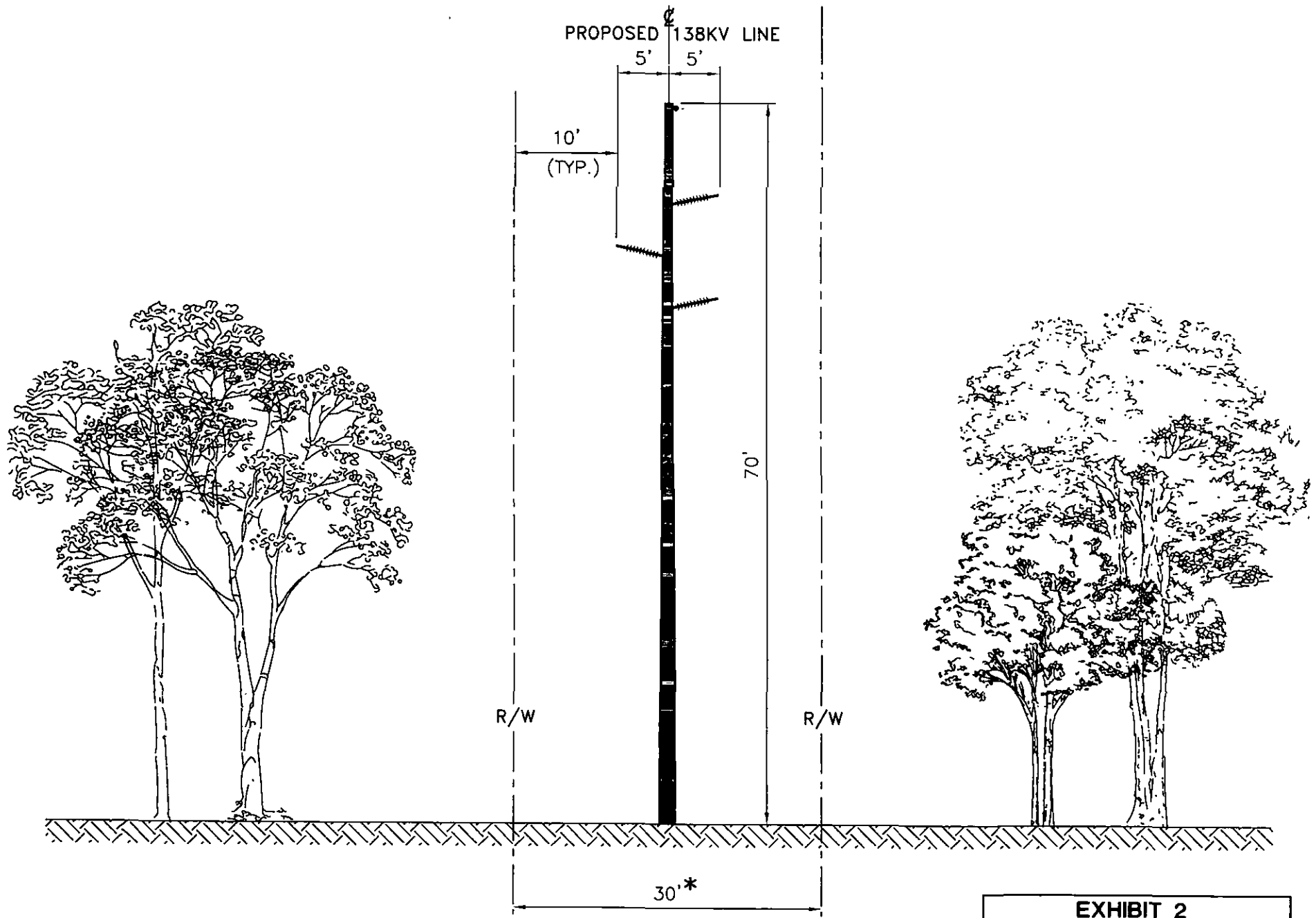



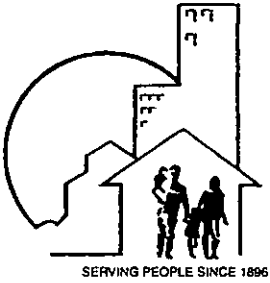
