3. PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy" or "Applicant") is a public utility corporation organized and existing under the laws of Pennsylvania, supplying electricity to the public in the City of Philadelphia and vicinity, including Montgomery Township and other municipalities in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.

4. Applicant proposes to construct one building in connection with the erection of an electric transforming substation, to be designated "Hartman Substation," on a site owned by Applicant, located on Domorah Drive near Corporate Drive, adjacent

to Applicant's transmission line right-of-way, in Montgomery Township, Montgomery County. An annotated aerial photograph showing the location of the proposed Hartman Substation is attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A". Applicant acquired said property by negotiated transaction with a local commercial/industrial park owner.

5. The proposed building, and the associated substation, is located in a commercial/industrial park with Limited Industrial zoning, and is surrounded by industrial buildings/sites. The nearest residence is approximately 1400 feet (1/4 mile) from the proposed substation.

6. The proposed building is necessary to house 34 kV switchgear and control equipment for the operation of the 230 kV and 34 kV substation equipment. The building will be erected on the aforesaid tract of land comprising four acres owned by the Applicant.

7. The proposed construction at Hartman Substation will include a takeoff from PECO Energy's existing 230 kV transmission line, and construction of a 230kv – 34kv duplex substation. PECO Energy intends to construct one-half of the duplex substation at this time, and to construct the remaining portion of the substation as load continues to develop in the area.

8. PECO Energy will place the Hartman substation in service for the summer of 2006. To accomplish this in-service date, construction must begin by May, 2005.

9. The proposed situation of the building is necessary for the convenience and welfare of the public for the following reasons:

- i. The equipment to be housed in the building is essential to the safe, efficient and economical operation of the outdoor substation.
- ii. The equipment must be located in close proximity to the outdoor transmission substation facilities in order that the connections to other equipment will be as short as practicable, thereby minimizing the likelihood of failures which would result in outages or misoperation of substation equipment.
- iii. The buildings should be in close proximity to the outdoor switching substation facilities for the efficient and convenient operation and maintenance of the entire substation installation.
- iv. The new substation is part of a project required to provide the capacity necessary to serve existing and new load expected to be connected in the Montgomery Township area.

10. PECO Energy has evaluated the electric and magnetic fields that will be associated with the new substation facility. Because the substation is a point source, electric and magnetic field levels will decrease rapidly with distance from the substation. Consequently, by the fence line electric and magnetic fields will be similar to background levels. As noted previously, the nearest residence is approximately 1400 feet (1/4 mile) from the substation.

11. PECO Energy engaged in extensive public outreach with local residents and local government in selecting the site for the Hartman Substation. PECO identified a number

of potential sites, then focused its consideration on three sites in the Township, each of which was geographically and electrically located in proximity to its transmission facilities. PECO Energy held an open house style public meeting in the immediate neighborhood of each of the sites to provide the public with information regarding the proposed substation and to receive input from the public regarding their views on the appropriate site for the Hartman Substation. In addition, PECO Energy conducted one-on-one meetings and letter communications with numerous local residents. In all, PECO Energy communicated with hundreds of local residents. Community sentiment was strongly supportive of the chosen site on Domorah Drive near Corporate Drive.

12. PECO Energy also engaged in outreach with the municipal government throughout the course of its siting selection. As a result of the outreach to the local government and residents, the Township's Board of Supervisors issued a public Resolution expressing the Board's support for PECO Energy's public outreach program, and further supporting PECO Energy's efforts to locate a suitable site in the commercial/industrial park. The Township's Resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked as Exhibit "B."

13. The site for the Hartman Substation is in a commercial/industrial park. Several sites within the commercial/industrial park were initially considered. PECO worked with the local business community, primarily the owner of the commercial/industrial park in question, to choose the final site within the industrial park. Ultimately, when none of the then-available sites were satisfactory, the owner of the commercial/industrial park

offered the site on Domorah Drive to PECO Energy as a site that would be satisfactory from a business perspective.

14. PECO Energy therefore purchased the Domorah Drive site, contingent upon obtaining Commission approval for the site. The transaction involves a tax-free exchange of property. PECO will obtain a fee simple interest in the four-acre site on Domorah Drive. In return, it will provide an easement on a five-acre parcel owned by it, located on Route 309 where that road intersects PECO's transmission line corridor. The easement is for limited purposes associated with parking/storing cars and access to parking areas for a car dealership on Route 309.¹

15. Under the presently effective zoning ordinance of Montgomery Township, the proposed building site is located in a Limited Industrial (LI) District. Public utility facilities are not listed as an approved use in the LI District. However, Section 230-141 of the Montgomery Township zoning code provides an exemption for any public utility building by deferring to the Commission, stating that an exemption will exist when the Commission finds that the building is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public.² The site is therefore unavailable under the Montgomery Township zoning code unless, under Article VI, Section 619 of the Act of July 31, 1968,

¹ The easement granted by PECO Energy involves, in part, a secondary use of a transmission line right-of-way. By definition, the property rights being granted by the easement are for real property that is not being used to provide public utility service. However, to the extent necessary, PECO Energy requests that the Commission approve its disposition of this easement pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3).

² Montgomery Township Zoning Code, § 230-141. Public utility corporations. This chapter shall not apply to any existing or proposed building or extension thereof or to any land used or to be used by a public utility corporation if, upon petition of the corporation, the Public Utility Commission shall, after a public hearing, decide that the present or proposed situation or use of the building or land in question is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public.

P.L. 805 (53 P.S., Sec. 10619), known as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code," the Commission shall find that the proposed situation of the buildings is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public."

16. Based on the extensive discussions that it has had with local residents and local government during its public outreach program, PECO Energy believes that no party will request an evidentiary hearing in this matter. However, PECO Energy requests that, even if no evidentiary hearing is requested, the Commission should schedule a public input hearing to take place in Montgomery Township. PECO has two reasons for making this request: (1) in its outreach program, local residents frequently inquired as to whether they would have the opportunity to make a statement to the Commission regarding the site to be chosen for the Hartman Substation, and (2) the Township's zoning ordinance only grants an exemption from local zoning if the Commission's determination is made "after a public hearing."

17. Upon filing this application, PECO Energy will provide public notice of its filing by: (1) publication in a local newspaper, (2) letter notification to local residents that participated in the public outreach and requested such notice, (3) providing a copy of its filing to the local government.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays your Honorable Commission to (1) publish such additional public notice as it deems necessary, including publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin if needed, at the Commission's earliest convenience; (2) direct PECO Energy,

at the Commission's earliest convenience, to make such additional public notification of this filing as the Commission may deem necessary; (3) fix a period for the filing of interventions and protests of 15 days from publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, if the Commission orders such publication, or within 15 days of publication in a local newspaper, if the Commission does not order publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin;³ (4) if an evidentiary hearing is requested in any timely-filed intervention or protest, to expeditiously determine whether an evidentiary hearing is necessary and, if so, to schedule such hearing as soon as convenient, (5) if no evidentiary hearing is requested in a timely-filed intervention or protest, to thereafter expeditiously schedule a public input hearing in Montgomery Township to take public comment on the proposed site;⁴ (6) to the extent necessary, approve PECO's Energy's disposition of an easement for secondary use of approximately five acres of its real property along Route 309; and (7) find that the proposed situation of the said substation buildings is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public.



³ The timing of protests to an application is ruled by 52 Pa. Code § 5.53, which in turn references the timing provisions of 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(d). That section allows a minimum of 15 days after publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. Given the extensive public outreach already conducted by PECO Energy, it believes that a 15 day period to file protests and interventions is sufficient to allow any interested party to intervene or protest.

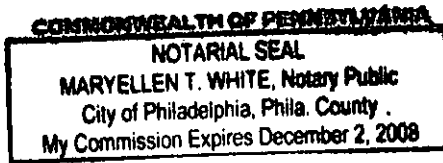
