

1. Petitioner is the Philadelphia Area Industrial Energy Users Group ("PAIEUG").

3. On August 9, 2006, PECO Energy Company ("PECO" or "Company") filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC" or "Commission") an Application for authority, pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102 and § 2102, for future transfers of property that is used or useful in the public service and that may involve transactions with other subsidiaries of PECO's corporate parent, Exelon Corporation. PECO proposes to make these future transfers under a multi-utility agreement, known as the Spare Transformer Sharing Agreement ("Spare Transformer Agreement" or "Agreement").

4. On August 26, 2006, notice of PECO's Application was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, and the PUC requested that any Petitions to Intervene be filed by September 11, 2006.

5. PAIEUG is an ad hoc group of energy-intensive customers receiving electric service from PECO under Rates HT (High Tension Power) and PD (Primary Distribution Power). PAIEUG members use substantial volumes of electricity in their manufacturing and operational processes, and these electric costs are a significant element of their respective costs of operation.

6. At this time, PAIEUG does not have any significant concerns to posit with respect to PECO's Application; however, PAIEUG recognizes that other parties may raise issues with respect to this Application. In order to ensure that PAIEUG has procedural standing in this proceeding in order to respond to any issues raised by any other parties that could affect PAIEUG members' rates or services, PAIEUG submits this Petition to Intervene pursuant to the timeframe set forth in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

7. Accordingly, because the Commission's resolution of the issues in this proceeding could impact the rates, terms, or conditions under which PAIEUG members receive electricity service, PAIEUG has an interest in this proceeding that is not represented by any other party of record.

WHEREFORE, the Philadelphia Area Industrial Energy Users Group respectfully request that the Commission grant this Petition to Intervene and provide PAIEUG with full party status.






