- (4) a proposed schedule for discovery, if believed necessary;
- (5) any admissions or stipulations;
- (6) the factual issues to be address in this case;
- (7) the legal issues to be addressed in this case;
- (8) the names, titles and business addresses of each witness;
- (9) the issues each witness will address;
- (10) a proposed schedule for the submission of written testimonies;
- (11) a proposed schedule for evidentiary hearings;
- (12) a proposed schedule for main and reply briefs;
- (13) any other pertinent information.

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The parties are encouraged to communicate with each other and arrive at mutually acceptable proposals. A representative of the parties may call me regarding the dates I am available for hearings in this case.
