



C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Affiliated Power Purchasers Inc expires on 8/30/2003.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. 



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

C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the expiration of the bond or other approved security provided by Affiliated Power Purchasers, Inc. occurs on August 30, 2010.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

Affiliate Power Purchasers International, LLC ("APPI") is writing to respond to a letter it received dated June 20, 2011 from Robert Wilson, Director of the Bureau of Fixed Utility Services, regarding the Renewal of the bond or other security relating to our license Docket No. A-110041. A copy of the letter is enclosed.

The initial security approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PA PUC") and provided by APPI many years ago was a \$10,000 Letter of Credit. APPI has provided a renewal of the Letter of Credit each year to meet APPI's obligation to provide approved security pursuant to the requirements of 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d).

The Letter of Credit now has an expiry date of August 30, 2011. APPI is in the process of obtaining the renewal of the \$10,000 Letter of Credit with PNC Bank.
