RE: Security Requirement for Washington Gas Energy Services:

Dear Melanie,

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C. S. § 2208 (c), an applicant for a natural gas supplier license in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania must furnish security to each utility where the supplier will do business to ensure the financial responsibility of such natural gas supplier. To this end, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("National Fuel") has performed a credit review and analysis of Washington Gas Energy Services ("WGES") and has determined that WGES must post a security deposit in cash, or a form of security acceptable to National Fuel, to operate as a supplier on National Fuel's system.

WGES's security requirement to serve Pennsylvania customers is dependent on the type of transportation service utilized by WGES. There is no Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) security requirement for customers that will be enrolled in National Fuel's Purchase of Receivable (POR) program. As such, WGES will not be required to post security for customers enrolled in the POR program. A security deposit will be required for transportation customers not enrolled in the POR program.

Philadelphia Gas works (PGW) is aware that Washington Gas Energy Services has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the services territory of Philadelphia Gas Works.

As you know, in making such an application, Washington Gas Energy Services must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Washington Gas Energy Services will do business. 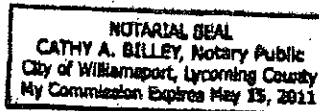

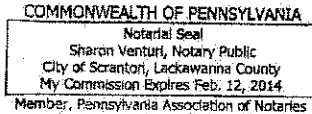


