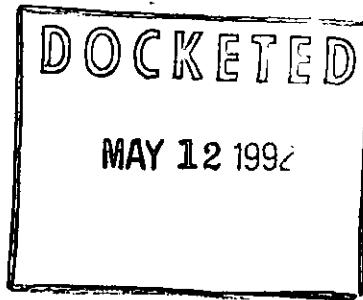

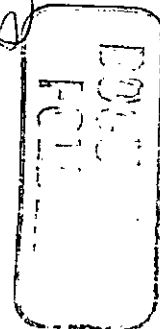

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has received notice that you are conducting public utility service under a trade name which has not been registered with the PUC. In order to legally conduct business in this manner, your PUC authority must be amended to include the trade name.

If you wish to add this trade name to your PUC authority, it will be necessary to submit a letter of notification to the Commission, attention Bureau of Transportation, containing the following information:

1. The docket number and name presently shown in Commission records.
2. The trade name to be added.
3. If the trade name is fictitious, a copy of the stamped registration form filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth. (information and forms can be obtained from the Department of State at 717-787-1057)

Upon submission of this information, the Commission will issue an order adding the trade name to your certificate, permit or license. Within 30 days of the entry of this order, you must make the change on your tariff.
