In accordance with the provisions of Act 294 of 1978 (66 Pa. C.S. §332(h)), the decision of the Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding has become final without further Commission action and the compliance order is enclosed.

The applicant will not be permitted to operate or engage in any transportation granted by the enclosed order until a tariff has been prepared and filed in accordance with the enclosed instructions.

Motor carriers operating without complying with the above requirement will be subject to the penalty provisions of the Public Utility Code.

Commission regulations require compliance with the above requirement within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter. Failure to comply within the sixty (60) day period will cause the Commission to rescind this action and dismiss the application without further proceedings.

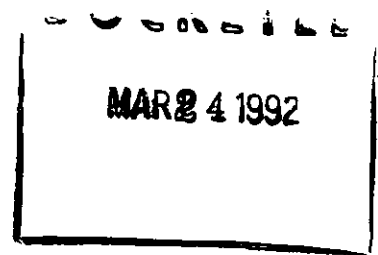

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Tri-County Transportation & Leasing, Inc. at Docket No. A-107235, F. 1, Am-A be and is hereby approved and that the certificate issued to the Applicant at Docket No. A-107235, F. 1, be amended to include the following rights:


To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons, in group and party service, from points in that part of the county of Cambria lying on and north of U.S. Highway Route 22, to points in Pennsylvania.

2. That the Applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission on the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

3. That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be constructed as conferring more than one operating right.

4. That if the Applicant has not, on or before 60 days from the date of service of this order, complied with the requirements set forth above, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
